Appleby's: Informal dining, 6:30pm-11pm daily, daily specialties, wine by the glass, fresh pastries. Moderate prices.


The Marker: Fine dining nightly, Sunday brunch, semi formal dress suggested, for reservations please call 5010. Expensive prices.
