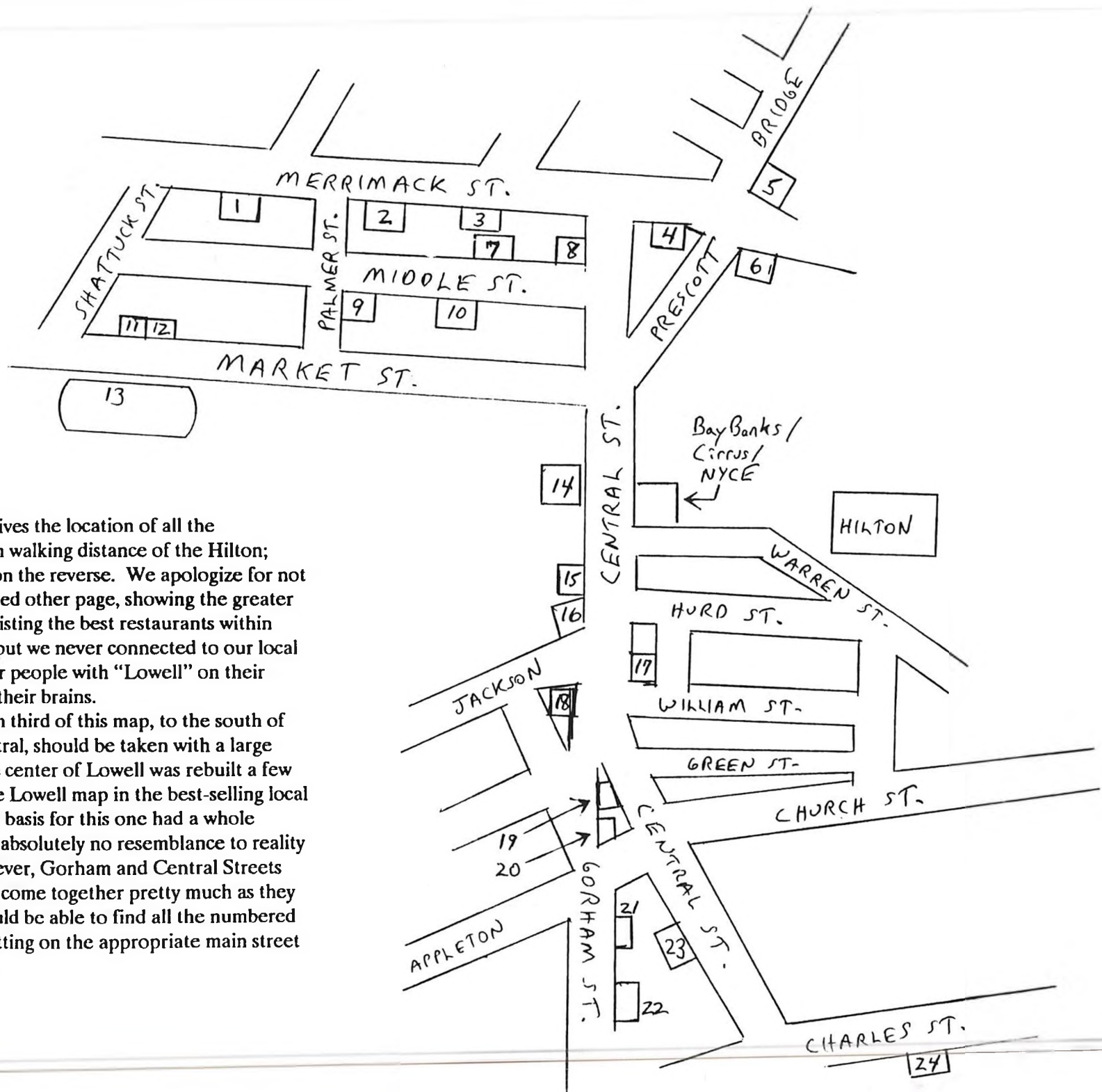


The Restaurant Guide

- 1) Heritage. Saturday 7:30-3:00. No prices posted. The only menu with even a vague nod towards trendy nutrition, but pretty mildly so by Cambridge standards.
- 2) Captain Pizza. Saturday 10:00-6:00. Regular pizza from \$3.50-\$5.00, large from \$5.50-\$9.50, slices 75¢; subs and spaghetti. Your basic Italian-style place.
- 3) Mossie's Sandwich Shop. Saturday 10:00-3:00. Subs, sandwiches, soups and salads from \$2.00 up.
- 4) Burger King. Saturday 7:00-11:00, Sunday 8:00-9:00.
- 5) Sunshine. No hours posted; was closed Saturday after 3:00 PM. Menu claimed homemade soups, sandwiches, \$2-\$3 range.
- 6) Brigham's. Saturday 8:00-8:00, Sunday 10:00-6:00. Is this chain of ice-cream and sandwich shops local to the Northeast?
- 7) Himalaya Restaurant. Saturday and Sunday, 11:00-3:00 and 5:00-10:30. Lunch specials c. \$5, entrees \$7-\$10. Visa, M/C, AmEx. Indian. The Chair and Program Chair ate here at SmofCon 3 a few years ago; it was quite good.
- 8) Press Club. Saturdays 11:00-10:00, Sundays 12:00-7:00. Sandwiches and burgers from \$3, specials and entrees \$6-\$11. Visa, M/C, AmEx, Diner's, Discover. Your basic American fare.
- 9) Palmer Restaurant. Hours not posted. Drinks, and sandwiches from \$3-\$7. American and seafood. Basically a bar that serves food.
- 10) A. G. Pollard & Sons Restaurant & Raw Bar. Saturday and Sunday 4:00-1:30 AM. They say entrees from \$5-\$8, though I remember more; where we took our GoH last year. Quite good, though not quite exciting.
- 11) The Athenian Corner, 207 Market St. Saturdays and Sundays 11:00-1:30 AM. Lunches c. \$5.00, dinners \$7.00-\$15.00. Visa, M/C. Greek food, live music and belly dancing; wine and liquor. Two lunch patrons raved about this place at length.
- 12) The Dubliner. Monday-Saturday 11:00-8:00. My scribe forgot to write down the prices; I'm guessing they were in the \$4.00 (for sandwiches and burgers) - \$10.00 range. Visa, M/C, AmEx, Diner's. American, seafood, daily specials. Under new management; the waitress gushed quite believably about the new chef.
- 13) Market Mills Melting Pot: Salads Plus, Oriental Cuisine, Burger Mill, Sweet Delights, Greek Delights, 4 Brothers Pizza, Taco Casa, Sugar Cone Sweet Shop. A standard mall food court, Saturday 8:00-5:00.
- 14) Sundance Cafe. Saturdays 11:00-12:00. Pitas and sandwiches \$2.50-\$5.00, entrees \$5.00-\$6.00. Mediterranean and American, wine and beer. I had a great kibby pita for lunch, while my wimpy companion had egg salad; we were both strongly tempted to go back for dinner (completely contrary to the purpose of our trip, of course). The closest food to the Hilton is good, and cheap—how about that!
- 15) Nick's. Saturday 7:00-3:00. Sandwiches, eggs, burgers \$2.00-\$5.00.
- 16) Ray Robinson Sandwich Shop. Saturday 7:00-3:00. More of the same.
- 17) Espresso Pizza. 12:00-11:00 Saturday and Sunday. Pizza from \$3.25, subs, burgers. We each had a slice here—typical mediocre Italian but with a better-than-average crust, certainly passable.
- 18) Cappy's Copper Kettle. Saturday 12:00-2:00 AM, Sunday 11:00-1:00 AM. A bar that serves dogs, burgers, and sandwiches real late and real cheap.
- 19) M____(?) Garden. Saturday 11:30-Midnight, Sunday Noon-9:00 PM. Fast-food ambience, Chinese.
- 20) Dana's. Saturday and Sunday 7:00-7:00. Ice cream and candy mostly, but eggs and sandwiches, too, starting at less than \$2.00.
- 21) Boston Fishmarket. Saturday 9:00-12:00. \$4.50-\$8.00. Seafood, fried and otherwise.
- 22) La Boniche. Saturday 5:00-10:00. Entrees \$12.00-\$17.00; M/C, Visa. "Simple dining with a French accent."
- 23) Four Seasons. Saturday 11:00-10:00, Sunday 4:00-9:00. Downstairs, a bar that serves lunches from \$2.50-\$4.00, burgers, salads, and entrees up to \$6.00; upstairs, a fancy restaurant, \$9-\$17 entrees, Visa, M/C, AmEx. American and Portuguese (which is heavy on seafood stews, for those who've never had it).
- 24) Dunkin' Donuts. We didn't go down there, but thought we'd mention it for you coffee and/or sugar fanatics.

This map gives the location of all the restaurants within walking distance of the Hilton; descriptions are on the reverse. We apologize for not having the intended other page, showing the greater Lowell area and listing the best restaurants within driving distance, but we never connected to our local sources. Look for people with "Lowell" on their badges and pick their brains.

The bottom third of this map, to the south of Jackson and Central, should be taken with a large grain of salt. The center of Lowell was rebuilt a few years ago, and the Lowell map in the best-selling local atlas we used as a basis for this one had a whole section that bore absolutely no resemblance to reality whatsoever. However, Gorham and Central Streets still exist and still come together pretty much as they do here; you should be able to find all the numbered restaurants by getting on the appropriate main street and sticking to it.
