## General

Name of Bid **Erasmuscon**

What dates are you bidding for? **17 – 20 august 2024**

**What is your proposed convention host city? Is your convention site in a city center location or a suburb? If a suburb, what are the transport options into the city centre? How far is the site from the city centre?**

Ahoy Convention Centre in Rotterdam 7 stops south by metro from Rotterdam Central Station

**What are your main facilities? How far are your hotels from your main venue?**

Ahoy Convention Centre, one hotel on site, other hotels between 2 and 7 stops north by metro, all on walking distance from stops, all stops have lifts

Schiphol and Rotterdam Airport both are international airports, Schiphol has a direct train connection with Rotterdam

Metro stop Rotterdam Zuidplein is approximately 200 meters from Ahoy
