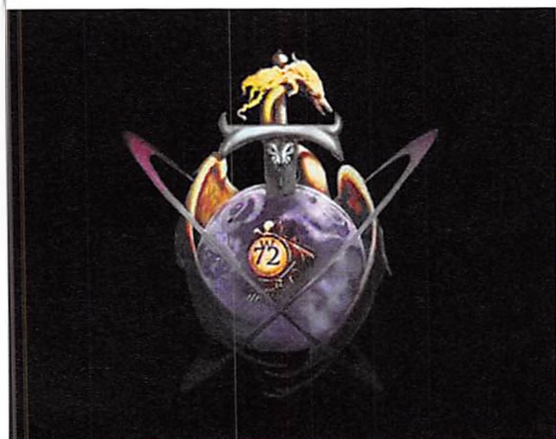

## WESTERCON HOTELS

The Utah Fandom Organization is preparing to release the hotel blocks for our 2019 event this late fall. Our new facilities department head, Mike Willmoth, is hard at work continuing our previous teams efforts and expanding them. We thought it would be good to highlight each of the hotels currently under contract for the convenience for our attendees.



### Hilton Garden Inn

The award winning Hilton Garden Inn is attached to the Davis Conference Center. Included amenities range from a fridge and microwave, a 37" LCD HD TV, and spacious work desks, to complimentary wireless high-speed internet access. The two buildings are separated by a spacious courtyard. The courtyard lies to the east side of the conference center and has access to the Fahrenheit Lounge, and the convention suite on the first floor.

The hotel is home to The Garden Grill.

### Home2Suites by Hilton

The Home2 Suites, a short distance across the street from the Davis Conference Center, is our designated party hotel. They have studio and one bedroom suites with a kitchenette, living area, and movable furniture. Free WiFi, iPod/MP3 docks, free breakfast, use of their pool or whirlpool, spin cycles and treadmills are available for guests. They also have a beautiful outdoor fire pit and outdoor grills. These parties should be in style, but the room numbers available are limited. (There will be a one night deposit required for our room block at this hotel.)



### Hampton Inn

Relax and unwind in a spacious guest room and enjoy modern conveniences to help you feel at home at the Hampton Inn and Suites behind the Davis Conference Center. This hotel offers free breakfast and beverage counters, internet access and an indoor pool, hot tub, and fitness center. Accessible transportation is available with advanced notice. This hotel does not have an accessible pool, but also includes many accessible amenities and information for everyone of the local tourist areas.

### Holiday Inn Express

The Holiday Inn Express may be our farthest hotel on the map, but its appeal is long worth the wait. Once you step out the door, cross a two-lane street, and through the Applebee's parking lot, you arrive at the Davis Conference Center. This inn offers a mini refrigerator, coffee mug, flat screen, black out curtains, and many other individual perks. They include internet and WiFi, breakfast, coffee and tea supplies, coffee in the lobby, off-site restaurant delivery available, and from the parking lot you can catch Golden Corral, and Outback Steakhouse.

Other hotels nearby, but not contracted (yet) include: Best Western Plus Layton Park, Layton. Towneplace by Marriott, Layton. Courtyard by Marriott, Layton. Fairfield by Marriott, Layton. Comfort Inn, Layton. La Quinta, Layton.

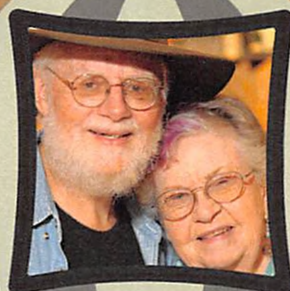

## TRANSPORTATION

Transportation, when it is not to the heart of a major city, is one of the first topics in mind when planning to go to a convention. We want to make it easy for you to feel secure in coming and leaving the July 2019 convention in Layton, Utah.

The Davis Conference Center is located off I-15 in Layton, Utah, and is just 20 minutes north of the Salt Lake International Airport. Additionally, Utah's Frontrunner Commuter Rail system is only minutes away. The Salt Lake International Airport Website provides all transportation information for your convenience including Trax, buses, shuttles, cabs, Paratrans, and route/parking information.

You can find any planning and route tools at the Utah Transit Authority Website. Please keep in mind the UTA site generally does not update routes and/or issues with routes more than 30-60 days out. Plan to mark your route using their tools a couple weeks before your trip to Utah. The address to enter for your destination is:

1651 North 700 West, Layton, Utah 84041

This address will pull up information to take Trax or Bus to the North Temple UTA stop. From there you can choose to take Light Rail/Trax to Clearfield and the Trolley or Bus to your destination of the Davis Conference Center. You can also download an app and pull up your own route.

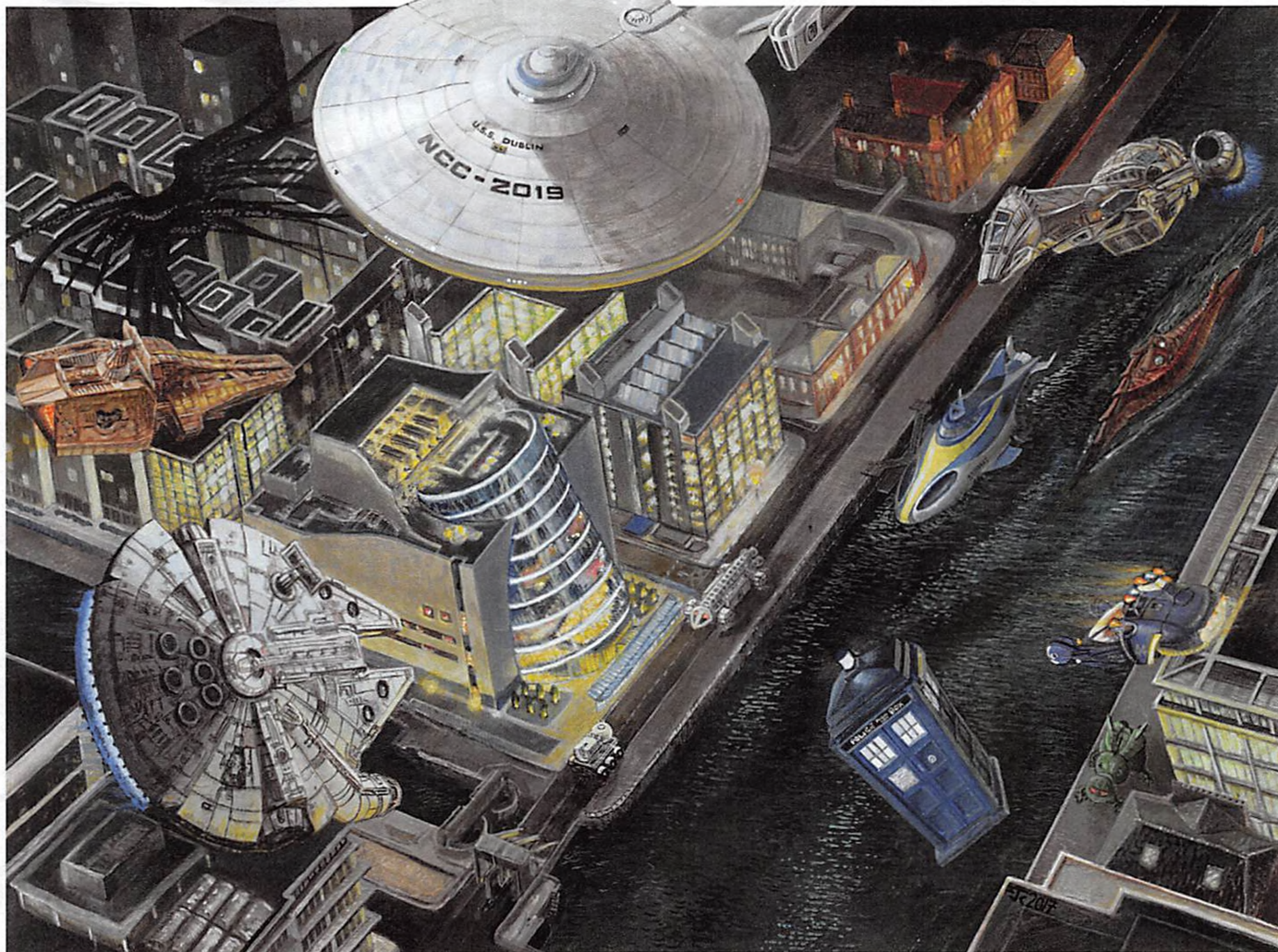
