Many of you will remember the Alexandria Hotel as the meeting place of the 16th World Science Fiction Convention held in 1958. The hotel is now in the process of extensive remodeling, and should present a fine appearance for the Westercon next year. The hallways have been repainted, the California room, which will be our Display Room, has been redecorated; many of the guest rooms --including all of those which will be allotted to members of the Westercon--have been refurbished, and new elevators have been installed. (They may be less adventurous but they are more certain.)

There will be a flat room rate for all convention attendees, and all rooms will be in the newly redecorated portion of the hotel. Insofar as possible, unless you request otherwise, all Convention rooms will be on the same floor, which makes socializing easy.
