Clinetown

Thanks to Spacecon, a last century Bay Area Relaxacon, we discovered the great wine of Cline Cellars. We have returned to the Cline tasting room in Sonoma many times.

It turns out the Cline family has roots in this part of Nevada, and these have borne fruit for Tonopah.

Winery co-founder Nancy Cline and family have been investing in Tonopah since 2011, when they purchased the shuttered Mizpah Hotel. Nancy's family roots in the area date back more than a century, when the twin frontier towns of Goldfield and Tonopah were the bustling center of the state's epic silver boom. Cline's grandmother, Emma Ramsey, was once the postmaster of Goldfield; Emma's brother Harry owned the first saloon in Tonopah, a modest enterprise with a tarp roof not far from where the Mizpah now sits.

Members of the Cline family now own the Mizpah Hotel, The Mizpah Club (the casino next door), and the microbrewery Tonopah Brewing Co. (check it out -- great beer and BBQ -- open Saturday 11-9, Sunday 12-8). Clines also purchased and remodeled the 19th-century Belvada building, which is now a hotel. Welcome to Clinetown!

Each package contains two tests.

Please do not wander around if you have COVID -19.

We have a limited number of test packages so this offer is only valid while supply lasts and only from July 1 8AM to July 4 8PM.
