NOTE TO HUCKSTERS: Be aware that in the City of Los Angeles a city sales license is required. Officials from the City Clerk's office may show up uninvited to enforce this law.

Hucksters' tables at Westercon 31 will go for \$25. The cost of the table is over and above the huckster's membership in Westercon 31. At Westercon 31 hucksters will have their own registration arrangements with the con so as not to waste time standing in lines that they could better spend setting up their merchandise. The details of this will be explained in the letter hucksters will receive before the con outlining the rules of the huckster room.



As convention membership grows, progress reports on Westercon become increasingly valuable advertising outlets. Beginning with a circulation of a couple hundred, the subsequent editions of our progress reports will rise to nearly a thousand copies, and by the time the Program Book has been handed out our circulation will outstrip all but the half dozen largest fanzines and convention program books. The following schedule is the minimum number of progress reports that will be published. The rates apply to both fans and pros.
