WisCon 14 To Invade Madison March 9-11

WisCon, Wisconsin's largest science fiction convention, as well as the world's largest feminist SF convention will be held at the Holiday Inn Southeast in Madison. Around 750 fans are expected to attend.

This year's guests of honor will be Emma Bull and Iain Banks. Emma Bull is the co-editor of the *Liavek* series, as well as the author of the urban fantasy War for the Oaks, and the newly released Falcon. She and husband Will Shetterly run Steeldragon Press which produces comic books and fine hardcover books. She is also a member of the rock group Cats Laughing.

Iain Banks is exciting new British writer with such novels as The Bridge, The Wasp Factory, Walking on Glass and Espedaira, behind him. He has received praise from the literary establishment for his writing. With the recently released Consider Phlebas and The Player of Games, he completes his emergence into the science fiction field. WisCon marks his first professional appearance at an American SF convention.

Convention Rates Set

This year the pre-registration attending rate has actually decreased from last year's rate. It will be \$14.00 for WisCon 14 pre-registration, and \$25.00 for at-the-door membership. Supporting memberships are \$7.00. Children under 12 are free but must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult WisCon member. Hotel Information

WisCon 14 once again returns to the Holiday Inn Southeast, home of the two previous WisCons. The Holiday Inn features 188 guest rooms, most of which are filled by WisCon attendees, a bar, restaurant, swimming pool, sauna, and free parking. Unfortunately, as in the past, there are very few restaurants nearby, so plan accordingly.

The Holiday Inn Southeast is easily accessible to people from other cities. It is located just off Interstate 90 and US 12/18. If you are approaching from the Interstate, take exit 142-B and head east. Take the first right turn and follow the Holiday Inn signs. Also very visible is the McDonald's sign. If you've found it, you've found us.

This year's WisCon room rates are \$43.00 for a single, \$49.00 for a double, \$52.00 for a triple, and \$55.00 for a quad.

Wiscon 14 will have a dealers room with many items for sale found only at SF cons.

Tables in the huckster room will be available on a first come first served basis, so act quickly to reserve your table. Applicants for tables must be WisCon members or pay to join WisCon at the same time they pay for the tables. If your membership is conditional upon getting dealer space, it will be refunded upon request if tables are not available.

Fees for the 6'x3' tables are \$25.00 for the first table, \$30.00 for the second, and \$35.00 for the third, with a limit of three tables per dealer.

Masquerade on Friday

Last year was the first WisCon in recent years to experiment with having the masquerade on Friday evening instead of Saturday afternoon. This year the masquerade will again grace Friday evening. This allows us to begin the dance during the masquerade judging, as well as leave more time for Saturday programming.

Volunteers
