The James Tiptree, Jr. Award

The Award returns to its birthplace for the fifth annual presentation. This year's judges (Marleen Barr, Nicola Griffith, Sarah Lefanu, Richard Paul Russo, and Nancy Springer) will honor works that explore gender issues in science fiction and fantasy.
