

## Writer's Workshop...

The second-ever WisCon writers workshop will run like the first, dividing participants into groups of about 5. including one professional guest critiquer. Everyone will receive their group's stories in advance to critique, and during the convention we'll all meet to discuss our reactions.

The deadline for submissions is May 1. Participants in this workshop will not do critiques by mail. If you want to get feedback, you have to be there. Send five (5) copies of one short story (up to 7,500 words) or one book chapter (up to 10,000 words). Book chapters should also include an outline if this is not the first chapter. Submissions must be in standard manuscript format: printed in 12-point Courier (type-writer) type; doublespaced; every page numbered. Send 5 copies plus a large self-addressed manila envelope and \$3 postage to Amy Axt Hanson, 923 N. Lawrence St., Tacoma, WA 98406.

Manuscripts will need to be postmarked by May 1. If you are interested in the workshop check the box on the registration form. This isn't a firm commitment but it will help to give us rough numbers.
