

P. 7, under "Movies", add: Projectionists: David Allsberg, Kris Sellgren, Milo Velimirovic, Rick White.

P. 8, under "GoH Reception", add: MC: Chris Bloczynski. Pianist: Brad Simonsen. Quinn would like you to know that her music is written in a modern style and is not like traditional classical music.

P. 10, under "Closing Ceremonies", add: Cold sandwiches will be available; hot ones will not. P. 11, add "Copyright Law and Fanzines": Panelists: Ellen Kozak, Hank Luttrell. Who really owns a piece of published writing or art? What if someone else uses it without permission? Are there any special problems that apply to fanzines? Is fandom a place to get away from the hassles of politics or are politics inescapable? Milwaukee fan Mike Lowrey will moderate this free-form forum. P. 13, under "The Future of the US Space Program", identify and add: Tom Pattison (for Sen. William Proxmire), Helen Vukelich (for Rep. Robert Kastenmeier).

P. 14, add "A History of Cartoons and Cartoon Strips": Presenter: William Feeny. A commercial art instructor at Madison Area Technical College and former worker on "The Lone Ranger" and "popeye" comic strips, Feeny will trace thi history of the comic strip and its relationship to social trends. He will show slides and illustrations from his collection. P. 14, under "Linguistics in SF", change: Karen Axness to Betty Hull. P. 14, under "Masquerade and Dance", add: Recorded Music: Diane Martin. Live music:

Bill Corse and Pulsar.

P. 15, under 'New Vampire', change: Greg Rihn (panelist, not moderator) to Jeanne Gomoll.
P. 16, under 'Poetry', add: Moderator: Keith Cohen.
P. 18, under 'SF and Education', add: Fanny J. LeMoine.

P. 20, add "Wimmin in Science": Moderator: Kris Sellgren. Panelists: George Fergus, Carrie Harris. Are there any women in science? Aside from Madam Curie, that is? Why not? Is this a Good Thing, a part of the Commie Conspiracy, or as interesting as stale toast? P. 20, under "Writers...", delete: Meredith Ackley.
