WISCON Program Book IN ERROR

With great shame, the WisCon committee has admitted to being **not** perfect. They make mistakes. Here are some of them:

1. (#3) Mike McFall is added to "The Wells/James Debate."
2. (15) Chris Bloczynski will replace Ann Chancellor on "Practicing SF Art".
3. (#25) Greg Rihn is added to "Brass Brssieres & Fur Bikinis"
4. (#28) "John Crowley--His Life & Works" is changed from 12 noon on Saturday to 2 pm on Saturday. It will be in LL2 (changed from LL3)
5. (#33) Neva Haycraft and Kate Nolan will join "Women in Technological Careers."
6. (#39) "Death in SF" has died. Consider it cancelled.
7. (#42) "More Women Writers you've Never Heard of" is changed from its 3 pm Saturday slot to 4 pm, and will move to the University Room.
8. (#53) "Uppity Women" moves from its Sunday 10 am slot to a 1:00 pm slot. Same room (Madison Room). This item is correct on your pocket program but incorrect in the program book.
9. (#54) Chris Gargan is added to "The Influences of Art Deco in SF".
10. We forgot to tell you that supplies will be limited at the morning donuts and coffee eye-opener (8-10 am Saturday). Just a warning.
11. The Computer Room will be open from 6 pm - 10 pm on Saturday, as listed in the pocket program. (The program book listed somewhat abbreviated hours, i.e., 10 pm - 10 pm.)
12. Although the program book lists a room (LL3) as the location for the Games Room, this is a mistake, as in "oops". The Games function is a do-it-yourself event. For further instructions, read the description in the program book.
13. This panel is a new one: "Beginning Dungeon Masters" (with Frank Metzger of TSR). Dungeon Masters should bring questions and problems. 2 pm Saturday, in the University Room.

The YWCA will also be open for lap swimming and open hours during daytime hours. But you have to pay for that. Check with the registration desk for details.



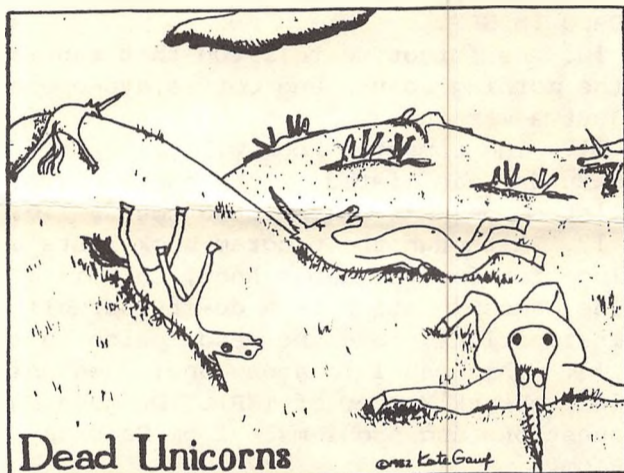
SERIOUS ANNOUNCEMENT

Wisconsin Law prohibits the sale of Liquor to people under the age of 18. It also prohibits minors from being present in a room where liquor is being sold or consumed unless they are in the company of a parent or legal guardian. Because of this, the cash bars Friday and Saturday nights will be confined to the University room. No minors will be allowed in this room (unless accompanied by a parent or guardian) and no drinks may be removed from the room.

We will also be carding people at the hospitality room. Minors attempting to be served will be asked to leave.

The hotel is very concerned about not serving drinks to minors because failure to comply with state law means the hotel could lose its liquor license.
