WORLD FANTASY AWARDS RULES

Following are the procedures for the selection of the nominees and winners for the World Fantasy Awards:

I. QUALIFICATIONS OF MATERIAL:

- a. Material must have been published for the first time during the award year (magazines must have a cover date for that award year).
- b. Collections and anthologies must have been published for the first time during the award year.
- c. Publication is not restricted to the United States, or to the English language; however, authors/editors of foreign material(s) may, in writing to the Awards Administration, withdraw their material(s) in favor of an American editor.
- d. All awards are restricted to living authors, editors, etc.; however, exceptions may be had by the Awards Administration.
- e. Nominees will be notified prior to publication of the final ballot. Withdrawals for whatever reasons must be made in writing to the Awards Administration; all correspondence in this regard will be held confidential.
- f. Sitting judges are not eligible for any category awards.
- g. Special Award winners are not eligible in consecutive years.

II. CATEGORIES:

- a. Life Achievement
- b. Special Award - Professional (editor, publisher, etc.)
- c. Special Award - Non-professional (editor, publisher, etc.)
- d. Best Artist
- e. Best Novel (40,000 words or more)
- f. Best Short Story (Less than 10,000 words, in year's with Best Novella category)
- g. Best Collection / Anthology (original or reprint)
- h. Best Novella (Between 10,000 and 39,999 words; this category will be added on a year by year basis, when the Awards Administration is advised there is sufficient work of eligible length)

III. AWARDS PROCEDURES

- a. A panel of select judges will be chosen by the Awards Administration no later than 15 January of the awards year. All judges should be willing to read the material, and have some broad knowledge of the fantasy field. The number of judges shall be five.
- b. Members of the two immediate conventions prior to the awards year, and the members of the awards year convention, shall be sent a ballot on which they may nominate up to five (5) names/titles in each of the categories.
- c. This membership balloting shall be completed and tallied no later than 30 June of the awards year in progress.
- d. The two (2) items in each category on the membership ballot which receive the most nominations will automatically be placed on the final ballot.
- e. Immediately following the completion of the membership balloting, the judges will be asked to submit in secret a list of five nominations, in no particular order, in each category; each item receiving two (2) or more nominations will be added to the final ballot, making a total of five (5) in each category (excluding possible membership or judge ties).
- f. If, on the nomination ballot by the judges, no item receives the requisite number of nominations, the judges will be notified of same and requested to submit a second ballot, this time the items to be listed in order of the number of nominations received on the first ballot.
- g. Nominees on the final ballot shall be notified within one week of that ballot's preparation.
- h. The judges will then participate in a second secret ballot to determine the winner in each category.
- i. The winner shall be defined as that item which receives the most votes in each category.
- j. Ties will be broken by a second secret ballot. Should a tie persist through this second ballot, however, duplicate awards will be presented.
- k. In exceptional cases, and with the agreement of the Awards Administration, the convention may present an out-of-category award, not to exceed more than one in any given awards year, and for which the convention chairman will consult the Awards Administration on his selection sufficiently before the convention itself.
- l. The announcement of the list of winners will not be made until the awards year convention.
- m. The administration and the chairman will consult sufficiently before the annual convention on what inducements the conventions may offer to encourage the attendance of the annual judges and awards nominees.

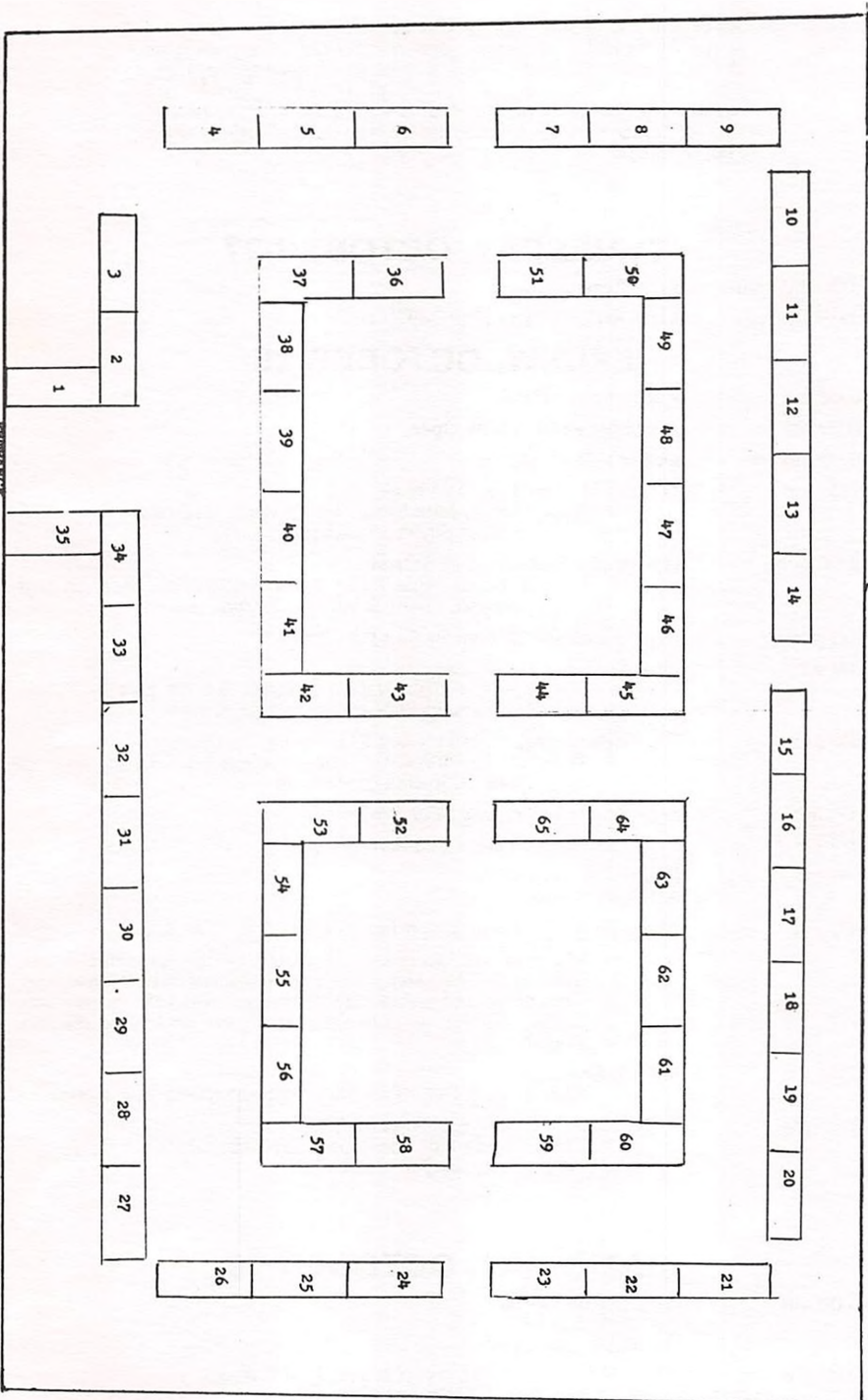

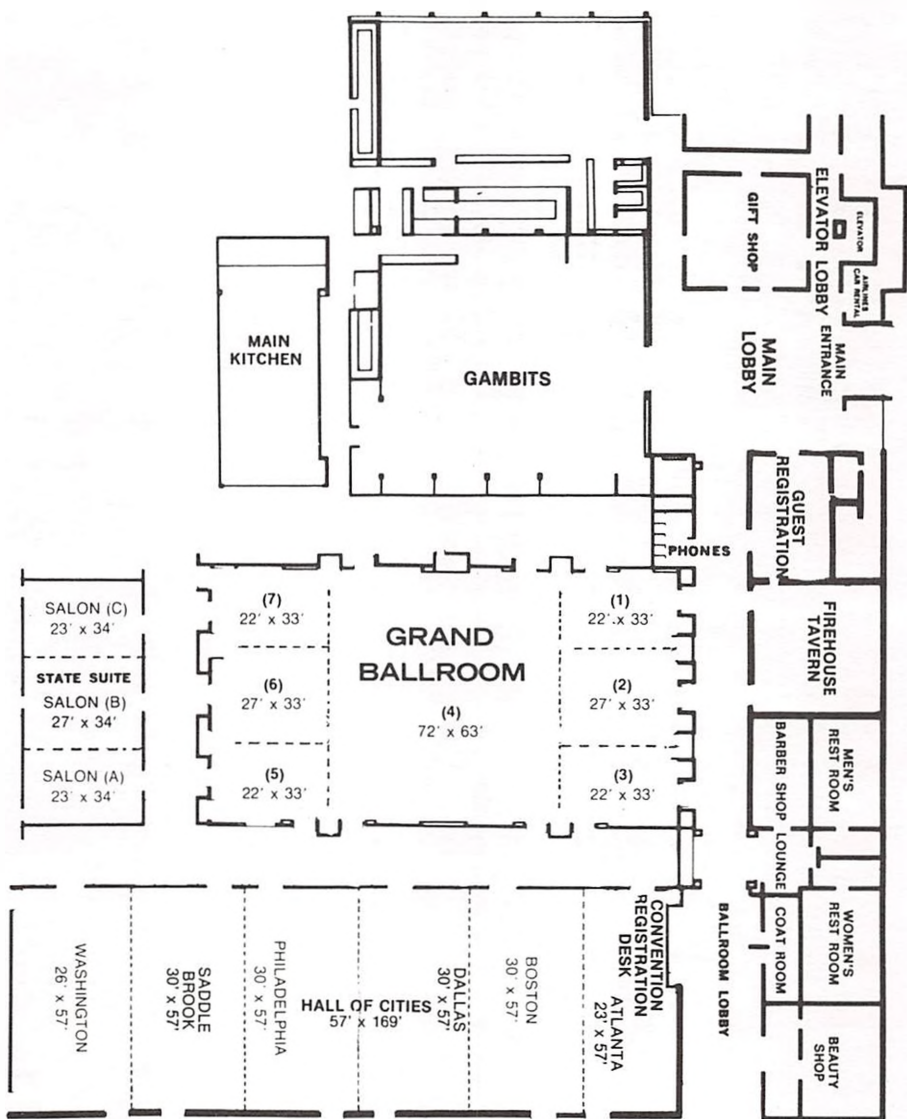

SIXTY YEARS OF WEIRD TALES

The Convention is pleased to present a unique exhibit of material celebrating the sixtieth anniversary of *Weird Tales* magazine. The exhibit, located in the Art Show Room features many of the rarest issues of this famous magazine. Also included are several original cover paintings done for the magazine. Original illustrations for the magazine are on display. There is also correspondence from Farnsworth Wright, the magazine's most famous editor, as well as a *Weird Tales* rejection slip and a *Weird Tales* Club membership card.

RARE BOOK AND ART AUCTION

Materials for this auction of manuscripts, rare books, fanzines, original art and other collectibles will be on display in the Art Show Room Friday and Saturday. All items will be displayed with the minimum bid listed. On Saturday evening, all items will be put up for auction. Payment will be by cash, travelers check or credit card (MASTER CARD or VISA). 6% Illinois Sales Tax will be added to all purchases at the Auction and Art Auction.

WHERE TO EAT

The Hotel features a number of excellent eating establishments. The *Fairfield Inn* is open from very early morning till quite late at night and features a full menu at reasonable prices. The *Firehouse Tavern* features sandwiches at lunch along with the usual liquid refreshments. *Gambits* is an elegant restaurant (with prices to match) in a cozy, library setting. Food is exceptional. Their luncheon buffet is excellent as is the Sunday Champagne Brunch. The *Kona Kai* is a large restaurant that offers both exotic and traditional meals.

While the hotel is in a residential neighborhood, there are a number of places to eat in the area. The *Rusty Scupper* is just beyond the hotel to the west and features a good seafood menu. Only a few blocks to the east is *Club Villa Pizza* and a *Howard Johnson's*. About a mile to the south on Cumberland is *Dapper's Family Restaurant* and a *Bressler's Ice Cream Parlor*. Further south, at Lawrence and Cumberland is a *Pot and Skillet Restaurant* (open 24 hours a day). Still further south on Cumberland (about 5 minutes by car) is a *MacDonald's*.

If you go south on Cumberland to Lawrence and then take Lawrence east till Harlem (around 10 minutes by car) you will come to *Nancy's Stuffed Pizza*. This unique Chicago feast is a must for pizza lovers and Nancy's Stuffed Pizza has been voted the best in the city. Unfortunately, there is a 40 minute wait for tables and the pizza takes 45 minutes to make. A phone call in advance (867-4641) is advised. Nancy's is open till 3 AM on Friday and Saturday.

Sandwiches are also available at the *Jewel Supermarket* [at Cumberland and Higgins] and the *White Hen Pantry* (south on Cumberland at Summerdale). There are several liquor stores in the area.

For those looking to get away from the convention for an evening, Chicago is noted for its many great restaurants. Unlike many cities, not all of the best eating establishments are clustered downtown, but are scattered throughout the city and suburbs. The Kennedy Expressway right by the Hotel affords a quick drive to many of the city's finest. Ask the convention staff for recommendations. As with all fine dining establishments, reservations on the weekend are a must (directions from the hotel can be obtained by that same phone call). For those without a car, the El provides quick and easy transportation downtown and many restaurants are quite close to the stops. Again, a phone call for both directions and reservations is a must.
