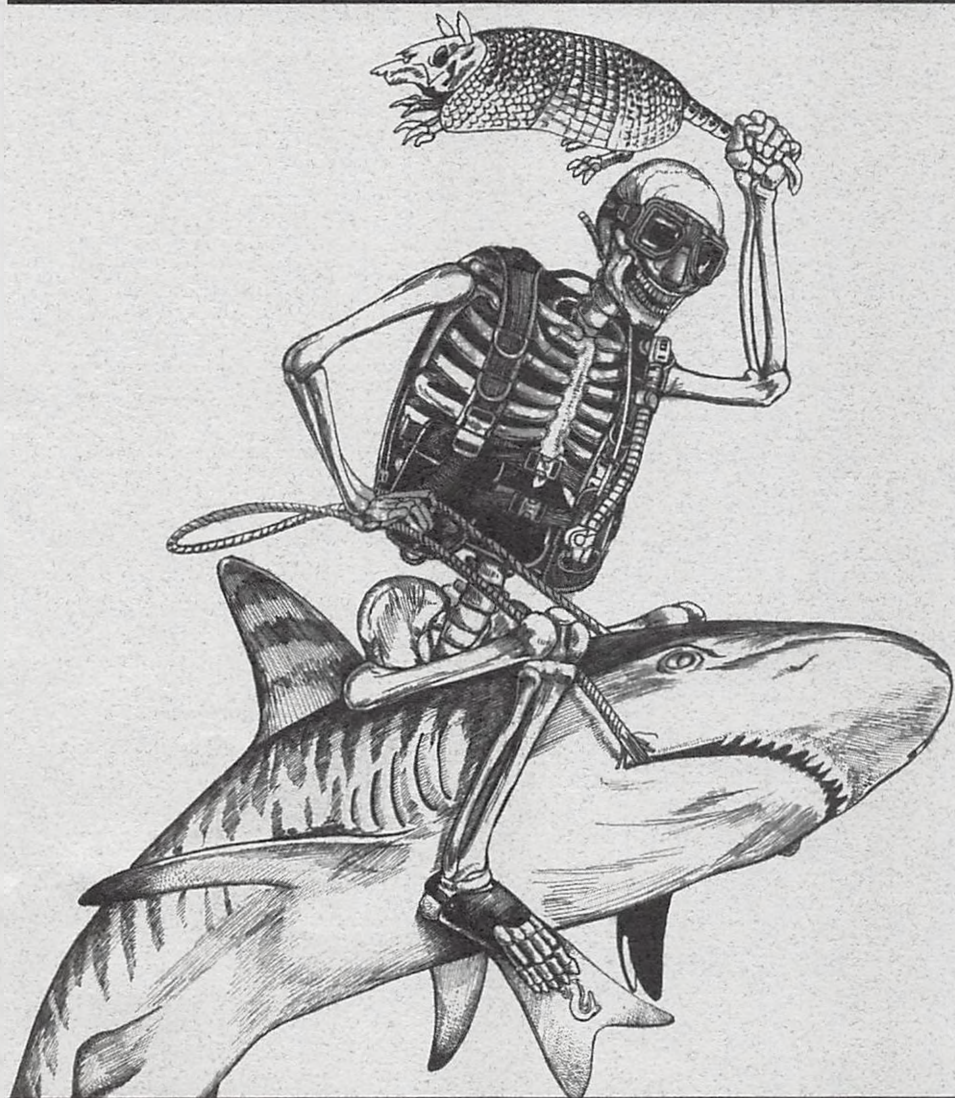

Official AIRLINE

Southwest Airlines Gets the Nod

After much consideration, we have decided to go with Southwest Airlines as the "Official" airline this year. They offer the most arrivals and departures into and out of Corpus Christi; in addition, they use full size 737 jets exclusively while the other airlines will use commuter planes to Corpus depending on the number of passengers per flight.

To take advantage of Southwest's low fares, call 1-800-433-5368 and ask for I.D. code A 5674, and get 10% off most of the fares to and from Corpus Christi. Please call from 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM Monday through Friday and 9:30 AM to 3:30 PM Saturday and Sunday, all times Central. You must buy tickets at least five days prior to travel to take advantage of this offer.

There are at least 50 daily flights in and out of Corpus Christi daily; after Southwest, the two main carriers are Continental and American Eagle, the commuter carrier for American Airlines.

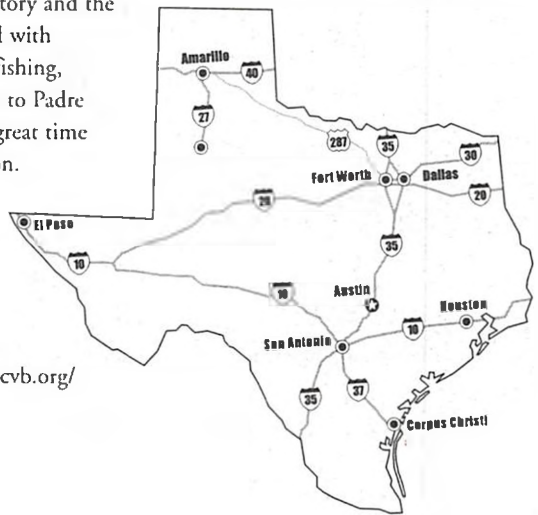
CORPUS CHRISTI

South Texas paradise

In 1519, on the Roman Catholic Feast Day of Corpus Christi, Spanish explorer Alonzo Alvarez de Pineda discovered a lush semi-tropical bay on what is now the southern coast of Texas. The bay, and the city that later sprung up there, took the name of the feast day celebrating the "Body of Christ." The spot Pineda discovered is now home to the largest city on the Texas coast, population 275,000, and is the sixth largest port in the nation.

With a beautiful bayfront, wonderful sea breezes and clear blue skies, Corpus Christi Texas has become a perfect destination for business or leisure travel. Downtown is minutes from beautiful beaches and famous attractions like U.S.S. Lexington, the Museum of Science and History and the Texas State Aquarium. 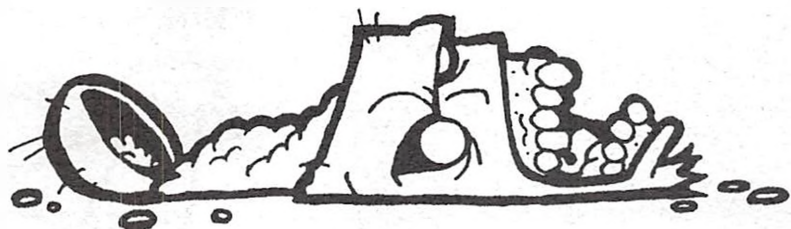

Technical Specs

The trim size of the program book will be 8.5" x 11" with no bleeds and prints at 133 line screen. The live area is 7.5" x 10". The preferred format is an Adobe Illustrator or Macromedia Freehand eps file with all images embedded and fonts converted to outlines. Adobe Photoshop files at 300 dpi are also expectable. I am doing the page layout in QuarkXpress 3.3 and can except Quark files however all hi-res placed images and fonts (Mac versions) must be included.

If it is not possible to provide your ad in one of the electronic file formats listed above I can except a velox or other high resolution output and have it scanned. Please avoid half-tones and screens if submitting your ad in this format as they tend to clog up.
