Shuttle Service: 6:00 – 11:00 PM

Hyatt Regency pick-up/drop-off: Wacker Drive in front of the East Tower

Adler Planetarium pick-up/drop-off: Solidarity Drive in front the museum

One bus will be equipped with a wheelchair lift in which there will be accommodation for 2 scooters or wheelchairs. Priority for this bus will be given to those with mobility devices and to their companions.

Gaze at the Stars! 4 telescopes will be set up on the Upper Terrace for our use. Docents will be available to help you navigate the night sky. Guests are encouraged to bring and set up their own telescopes on the Lower and Middle Terraces. Please note that guests are responsible for their personal telescopes.

Doane Observatory: Hours depending upon sunset (estimated to be open 8:00 – 10:30 PM). Entry to the Doane Observatory is around the back of the museum from the Lower Terrace. The observatory can hold up to 15 people at a time.
