STATEMENT FROM THE Los Angeles in '84 COMMITTEE

This year, the voting fee for the World Science Fiction Convention Site Selection is \$20 (US). This fee will entitle each voter to a full Attending Membership in the 1984 Worldcon. No conversion fee will be required.

Should Los Angeles be determined as the site, membership fees will increase to \$30 (US) immediately following the close of the 1982 Worldcon, Chicon IV.

Those people who do not vote and know they cannot attend the convention, but who wish to receive its publications, wish to nominate and vote for the Hugo Awards, and wish to vote in the 1986 Site Selection Balloting may purchase a Corresponding Membership. These will be available at a fee of \$20 (US) until 30 days prior to the start of the convention.

Corresponding Memberships may not be converted to Attending Memberships. (Information from recent Worldcons indicates that "Supporting" Membership fees of \$10 (US) and \$15 (US) have led to economic losses for those conventions and are, in reality, not supportive at all.)
