

Attending Denvention 3 on the Installment Plan

Denvention3 is pleased to announce that we have an installment payment plan for attending our convention. The installment plan is a way to lock in the current low membership rates while paying for it over time. You start by paying for a Supporting Membership, and then making regular quarterly payments of at least \$10. You have until July of 2008 to complete payment - at which time you will have a full Attending membership. You may also cancel your plan at any time for a partial refund (we'll refund the amount you've paid above the cost of your initial Supporting Membership), or transfer your membership even if you haven't finished paying for the plan.

The gory details:

- First you buy a Supporting Membership. If you voted in site selection for the 2008 Worldcon you already have a Supporting Membership. Your Supporting Membership fee is not refundable under any circumstances, but may be transferred. See the membership form for current rates. Be sure to indicate if you were a bid pre-supporter or voter.
- When you send in your membership form for your Supporting Membership tell us that you want to pay for your Attending Membership on the installment plan. If you already have a supporting membership and want to pay by installments, please send in a membership form, letter, or email telling us that you want to buy your Attending Membership on the installment plan.
- Once you tell us you want to use the installment plan, we will send you an email or postal mail confirming your registration and telling you the amount you need to pay to convert to an Attending Membership. This mail will tell you when your first installment is due and give you specifics on how to make your payments.
- You must make a payment at least one \$10 payment every quarter (every three month period). Failure to make this minimum payment may cause us to cancel your installment plan.
- If a payment is returned for insufficient funds or any other reason your plan will be cancelled.
- You can cancel your installment plan at any time by contacting Denvention3 Registration. If your plan is cancelled (by you or by the convention) Denvention3 will refund the amount you paid towards the conversion, but the basic Supporting membership fee will not be refunded.
- When an installment plan is cancelled for any reason you forfeit your right to convert at your locked in rate. Once cancelled, an installment plan may not be resumed, and you may not start a new installment plan.
- You can transfer your Supporting membership and paid installments to another individual at any time. The person you
 transfer it to will be responsible for making the remaining payments as outlined above. If the plan is cancelled after you have
 made the transfer, any refund due will be sent to the new owner of the membership.
