

Robert's Rules of Order Motions Chart Modified for WSFS



Based on Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised and the WSFS Business Meeting Standing Rules

Main/Subsidiary/Privileged Motions. These motions are listed in order of precedence. A motion can be introduced if it is higher on the chart than the immediately pending motion.
