PLEASE READ THIS, then take appropriate action!

The purpose of this questionaire is to compile the completest possible world-wide directory of s-f clubs and societies of all types: local, national and international -- including also specialised organisations such as APAs, confederations of clubs, youth groups, libraries and film societies, and s-f pen-friend clubs.

Eligible for inclusion in the directory will be individuals willing to form or take part in forming a club, or to contact newcomers in any local group which has no formal structure. Also included will be scientific associations etc., if they think it worth while to fill up the details.

Advantages:

A comprehensive list will make it possible for anyone to make speedy contact with those clubs of use to him. When each fanclub sends in its entry, the full details will be printed in the first available issue of HYDRA. This will spread over two or three months. Then, sometime around April 1966 the full list will be published in pamphlet form.

The directory will be a reliable and helpful guide, of academic as well as practical interest. It will show the degree of organisation of Fandom as of early 1966.

Our policy in the Hydra League is to make an attempt at giving useful service to active and inactive s-f fans the world over, and to support anything which increases the activity or efficiency of Fandom. In furtherance of this, every club secretary will go on the mailing-list of HYDRA for a few issues.

TO MEMBERS of any organisation: please forward this questionaire to your club secretary.

TO ORGANISATION SECRETARIES: The published entries may amount to as little as two or three lines or as much as a full stencil, depending on the amount of space

needed to describe your activity. The present position and past achievements, and plans for the future, can be included at full length.

If the questions don't fit your type of organisation, then ignore the irrelevant ones and volunteer the information you wish us to use.

TO THOSE who wish to start a new club, fill in your name and address and a brief description of the type of club you have in mind -- e.g. local, APA, correspondence, etc.

TO PUBLISHERS -- if you want extra copies of this "Science-Fiction Fan Club Questionaire" for distribution to your readers, let me know how many you could use.


