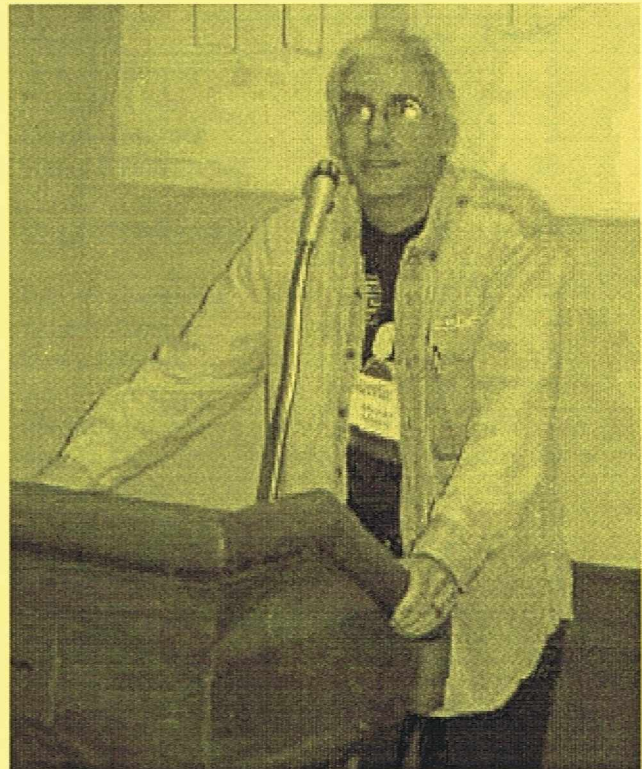

ANZAPAns triumphant at Corflu

This is the only apa that has three members who achieved mighty things at **Corflu 22**, 25–27 February 2005, San Francisco.

Murray Moore, named Guest of Honour of Corflu when his name was pulled out of a hat, and with only two days to prepare his GoH speech, delivered a gentle but blistering roast of the Corflu members that was 'funny as hell'.
