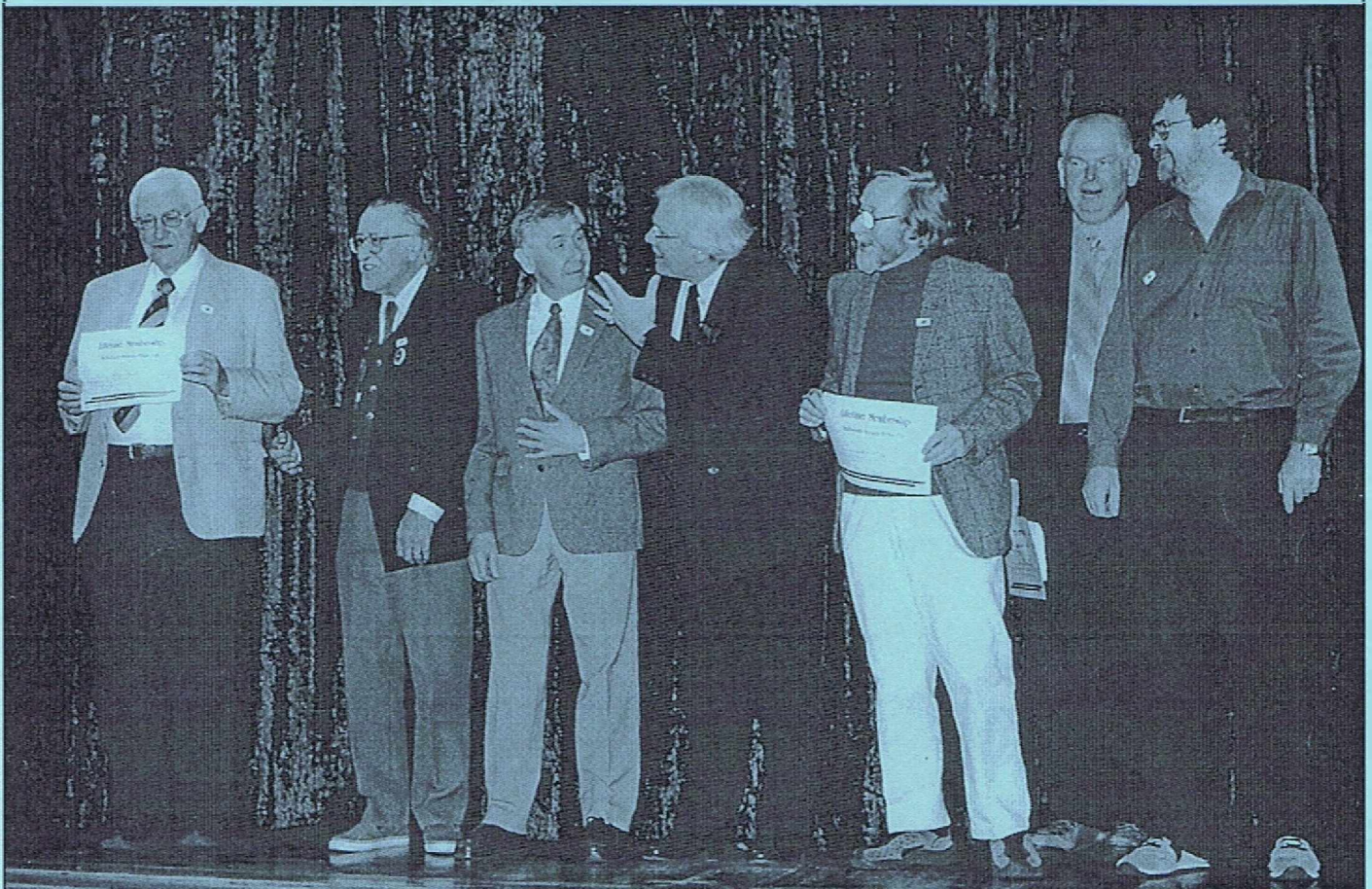

Pay up or drop out!

You should get your little yellow slips with this mailing, or in the mail a few days later. These tell you what you owe me for dues for the coming year (August–June). **David Grigg's** rule was Pay Up Real Soon or Drop Out. I'd better put on my most ferocious face and enforce the rule. My records tell me that Murray Moore has lots of credit, so he doesn't need to pay up.

According to the Constitution, I was supposed to let you know about changes to rates in the February mailing. However, you'll probably forgive me for not having read that bit of the Constitution. You see, I'm reducing all rates except the World Air Mail rate (which goes up by \$A2):

- Hand Delivered: \$8.00 per membership per year.
- Australia: Mailed: \$20.00 per membership per year.
- New Zealand: Air Mailed: \$A25.00 per membership per year.
- World Air Mailed: \$A60 per membership per year.

We have a fair bit of money in the ANZAPA kitty, but it now costs well over \$100 to post out a fat mailing. Let's see how the lower rates work out before reducing them further.

I have to talk to David Grigg about how he managed variable exchange rates. The Australian dollar has veered between 78 cents to the American dollar and 75.5 cents just within the last month or so. If it stays at about 76 cents, that makes the rate for American members \$US46. Okay, I'll accept \$US45 in American folding money for the time. I'm presuming that **Jean Weber** and **Eric Lindsay** can still process American cheques, but this might have to be sorted out during the next few weeks.

I'm not sure about the British pound. If the Australian dollar is currently trading at 42p... um, I need some high-flying financial help here. We'll discuss all this by email in the next week or so.

Just a reminder to our President **Sally Yeoland** that before the August mailing she needs to provide us with two sets of a poll to decide next year's Presidency. And everybody needs to consider who is worthy of that high honour for 2005–06.
