Membership matters

Glen Crawford has offered to resign (see his contribution this time), but he has paid his membership fees, and he would like to receive the next two mailings.

Glen's correspondence (more recent than this mailing's Kobwebs):

'Yes it is a recoverable injury, but it's pretty slow, believe you me. It's been just over 2 months now, and I have progressed from not being able to read the top line on the eye chart (the one with ONE letter on it) to being able to almost read the 4th line, the one with 4 letters on it. They tell me it's a 12-18 month recovery period, and what I've got then is the best I'll ever have again. I believe they can use glasses to correct some of the focus issues. Mine are complicated by the fact that I had cataract surgery a few years ago, so I have a fixed focal length lens in my eye. One of the "cures" was to put a silicon band around the eyeball, making it narrower and longer. This helps push the retina back in place, but it also lengthens the focal length, which my fixed length lens can't cater for. I'll just have to take it as it comes I guess. Don't worry about returning the dues, please consider it another donation to the ANZAPA cause. You could also send me the December disty if you like, that way I can at least try to "see" people's reactions to my news' (9 October).

'The eye is starting to improve again, I think I've got the infection finally beaten, so we'll see how much I can read of the next couple of issues' (11 October).

Lucy Schmeidler continues to improve (see her contribution), but Sally Yeoland has lost her beloved Tia (see her contribution; she shows that a cat is just too valuable a member of the family to lose).
