Dear Fans,

Well it is a while since you have heard from me and I am afraid that the delays between these sheets, and Etherline, will continue to be long. Every week I find I have less time to devote to science fiction.

Over the last couple of years I have been able to get hold of a few things which were not generally available. I have been quite happy to get these things for you, as the little profit I have been able to make has helped to keep the club going. However nowadays things are not so scarce with US pbs especially everywhere. Accordingly my range of titles I can get and be sure of selling is dwindling, a lack of interest is being shown in the club and besides this as I said before I am finding it hard to find the time to devote to things that I should.

For the time being though I will continue to send out these lists from time to time - and you may see two or three issues of E per year. If I can help you with any books, pocket books or mags I will be glad to try. What new pbs either US or British you want I can get from McGills for you if I don't have them myself. Quite a few titles we cannot import for general sale because of copyright tie-ups. That's the US titles of course. These I can always get myself and I can usually pick up any old and out of print items for you eventually.

Quite recently I put an advert in an American publication the Fantasy Collector for US material. The response has been good and quite a few people have written to me. As a service both to you and our US friends I intend to list here many of the people I know who are interested in trading. So may be some of you can get together yourselves.

Subscribers of Etherline may be receiving this with E but if not you can definitely expect it soon. Others who would like a copy please send 1/3 to cover cost and postage.

I regret that I cannot give you much news at the moment. A few things that do come to mind: Have been watching 'Men Into Space' on TV and it is very good. The last films we have seen - The Blob and I Married a Monster from Outer Space - both worth having a look see. Not very much new lately in the way of HC books - the Night of the Big Heat, Andromeda (Russian), Galactic Cluster (also seen in US pb) are a few that come to mind. Reviews and lists will be found in E and all titles available will be found in the attached McGills Advert.

Pocket books have been coming in by the mile but I will try and list all that we have in stock at McGills as well as the few I have myself. I might add here that if you have any orders for McGills of a pound or over send them direct and I will see that they are charged and sent to you. Smaller orders please enclose cash including 5d per item for postage and send direct to McGills. Mixed orders for both McGills and the Library (me) please send to me and I will either send my self or send from McGills according to the number which can be supplied from either source.

You will find marked on the pb lists the titles which you have previously ordered which I am holding for you. If time permits I will also list all other titles which you have on order.

If you wish to order any titles from Mr Rix, please write to him direct. You should have no trouble in sending the cash to him by Money Order or receiving the books through the post.

A full coverage of news will be given in E but I would like to mention that the US mags Fantastic Universe (Received one at McGills last week dated April - what a mess), Original SF, and Future SF have all ceased publication. Due here soon is Miller's 'A CANTICLE FOR LIEBOWITZ' from the stories published in F&SF.

An important note, members of The MELBOURNE SF CLUB: On the first Thursday in July, the 7th to be exact a special club meeting is to be held. Once again to discuss the continued operation of the club. Not enough members are attending regularly so we have to find some way of ensuring payment of the rent over the next year, if we are to renew the lease in August.
