Most of us cut our teeth on his 'Lensman' series and very few writers were quite as colourful in their descriptions of the fabulous 'space operad. Exagerated as they are they are still great fun to read and some of the most sort after books. Nearly all the Lensman books are out in pb now. Hugo Gernsback has been honoured by the World Convention naming the best SF Awards after him . Some thing should be done to honour 'Doc' Smith in the same way.

Talking about 'Hugos', for those of you who have not heard who the winners were at the last World Convention in London:

Best Novel The landerer by Fritz LEIBER (The best thing I have read since DUNE which I still think is

a certainty to win this year.)

BEST FANZINE: Yandro, EIST ARTIST: Schoenberger, BIST MAGAZINE:

Analog, PUBLISHER: Ballantine and BEST SF DHAMA: Dr Strangelove. This was the first World Convetion that was held I believe, outside the U.S.A. From all acounts it went be the last but this years will be at Syracuse .

Two new ACE titles have just arrived of Bert CHANDLERS. Empress of Outer Spacewith The Alternate Martians and Space Mercenaries with Caves of Lars by Petaja on the flip side. Believe it or not these titles were rejected by another publisher because they were to good.

A new series of British paperbacks from the publishers of New Worlds has started but they have not turned up out here yet. I hope they will be available soon from McGills . Watch for COMPACT Books.
