Lucy Sussex reports that this year's Tiptree Award winners are Nancy Springer for her novel *Larque On the Wing* and Ursula LeGuin for her short story 'The Matter of Seggri' (in *Crank*). "Shortlistees included George Turner for *Genetic Soldier* and Greg Egan for the short story 'Cocoon' (*Asimov's*). Nancy Springer got a clay Lark mask by Michaela Roessner plus cheque. Ursula got cheque plus a chocolate computer terminal filled with truffles. Judges' decision (Pat Murphy, Lucy Sussex, Brian Attebury, Ellen Kushner and Susanna Sturgis) was unanimous and amiable. Potlatch (where the award took place) turned out to be a small but fun convention. I have photos, which include a famous writer with a paper bag over her head, and another famous writer gagged."
