Meantime, in connection with the Sunday showing of the new Dr Who movie, Richard Nolan, President of the Dr Who Club of Victoria, gets quoted in the Age's Green Guide 4/7/96. (He mentions the comedians who have appeared in Dr Who, but forgets John Cleese!) Not to be outdone, Sydney's Dallas Jones gets a mention in The Weekend Australian July 6-7. 
