Proving that it is possible to work from Australia, Jack Dann reports

"White Wolf has bought Counting Coup, my road novel. I think of it as if On The Road written as magical realism. It will be a December 1996 release. They have also bought a short story collection entitled Jubilee and other Stories, to be published in 1997. This will be a big book, containing all my major work since Timetipping. The Memory Cathedral will be published in August by Gustav Lubbe Verlag in Germany. It has been given second fiction place behind Ken Follet. It has also recently sold to Hungary, the Czech Republic, and Russia. Recently sold short fiction includes "The Hanging" to Heartlands, a mainstream anthology edited by Peter Crowther and Edward E. Kramer, and "Blind Eye," to Science Fiction Age.

Gardner Dozois and I also turned in Timegates to Ace Books. Our anthology Hackers should also be out from Ace Books this year.

I'm also co-editing The White Wolf Rediscovery Trios.
