Rob Gerrand appeared, in his professional role, representing the ANZ Bank, on the Channel 9 News 13/6/97.

The Herald/Sun 18/7/97 features a piece about four minutes of bits snipped from Dr Who being found in Australia. It mentions Ellen Parry a postgrad at Brisbane University who is studying sf film and books and Sydney's Damian Shanahan who is writing a history of Dr Who censorship in Australia. The BBC has asked for the cuttings to be used in a forthcoming Dr Who special. And who said that censorship was a bad thing?
