The John Wyndham Archive Appeal

The University of Liverpool, which hosts the Science Fiction Foundation Collection, has put in a lottery bid to purchase the archive of British science fiction writer John Wyndham, author of The Day of the Triffids, The Midwich Cuckoos, etc.

The archive, priced £100, 000, is one of the fullest sf archives on the market. It is of major literary and biographical importance in the history of British science fiction. It is important that this record remains in the care

of an organisation committed to the preservation and access of such a collection and the promotion and scholarship of science fiction. The Science Fiction Foundation Collection already holds papers from several major authors, including Brian Aldiss, Ramsey Campbell, the late Eric Frank Russell, Colin Greenland,

Ramsey Campbell, the late Eric Frank Russell, Colin Greenland, and Stephen Baxter. In addition, we already hold two small collections relating to Wyndham, including his presentation copies of translations of his books and published and unpublished manuscripts of his brother, Vivian Beynon Harris. At present, the University is applying for Heritage Lottery Funding and for a Victoria and Albert Museum purchase grant to purchase the Wyndham archive and make it available to scholars and researchers interested in sf and fantasy and the works of John Wyndham. We would still need to come up with matching funding, and if we are successful in the purchase of the matching funding, and if we are successful in the purchase of the archive we would therefore require funds to preserve and archive we would distribute the science fiction/fantasy community for assistance, and have the backing of the patron of the science

fiction foundation. Arthur C. Clarke, who says
"The Wyndham archive is one of the most important
records in British sf and it is vital that it is acquired by the library to which it really ought to belon

A number of other British st/fantasy writers, including Brian W. Aldiss, have also expressed support for this project.

We are also grateful for the support of this year,s World Fantasy Convention who are backing our appeal. A proportion of the ticket money raised at the WFC Raffle will be donated to the Wyndham Appeal. We are asking for donations of suitable material - signed books, proofs, T-shirts, posters, memorabilia and other collectible items, as raffle prizes. We also welcome pledges of cash donations.

In the very welcome possibility of us raising more money than we need to actually purchase the material we would envisage that it would then go initially towards cataloguing and conservation/preservation of the Wyndham Archive and then towards the purchase or cataloguing and preservation of more material for the Science Fiction Foundation Collection.
