Since this zine is primarily a work-in-progress type of thing, I hope you will continue to make corrections and suggestions on material you think would be important to preserve and index.

Speaking of *FanHistorica*, it has been a long time between issues but hopefully, *FanHistorica* #5 is also included in this mailing.

FanHistorical Reference Shelf

Because I have been looking up and trying to cross-check all sorts of fannish material, I have set up my fannish references near-at-hand. There are a lot of possible publications that could be included — I originally listed a couple of hundred for the bibliography I did for Sanders' *Science Fiction Fandom* from Greenwood Press (and Joe added some others as well). However you can't keep that many publications on a shelf above your desk. My priority is for information I can look up quickly — bibliographies, histories, indices, and similar items.

Here is what I keep nearby. If you know of other worthwhile items, please let me know.

Bibliography:

- Pelz' Fanzine List (only goes to the letter S and to 1980) (about 25,000 zines)
- *FAPA Book* (Pavlat) (6 issues - listing of FAPA zines for the first 96 mailings.)
- *Timeless Sands* (Rowe) (New Zealand fanhistory & biblio) (I only have Vol. 1, the biblio)
- Siclari's Fanzine Checklist (about 8,000 zines — in rapid progress)
- Fanzine Indices (Fitch, Siclari & others)
- Fanzine Library lists (Clarke)
- British Fanzine Index (Roberts & Clarke)
- *A World of Fanzines* (Wertham) (to remind me that a reference can also be a waste of paper)

History

- *Noreascon 3 Program Book* (quite a bit of information about Worldcons)
- MidAmeriCon Progress Reports (contains Fred Patten's very good but aborted illustrated history of the Worldcon)
- latest Worldcon program book (to keep up to date info on Worldcons & Hugo winners)
- *Science Fiction Reference Book* (Tymn) (contains my History of SF Fandom and a comprehensive list of awards and nominees)
- *The Immortal Storm* (Moskowitz) (1930's fanhistory)
- *All Our Yesterdays* (Warner) (1940's fanhistory)
- *All Our Yesterdays* (Warner) (the British anthology of fanhistory columns)
- *A Wealth of Fable* (Warner) (1950's fanhistory) (it's a conceit but I keep both versions)
- *Then* (Hansen) (4 issues - British fanhistory)

General References

- *Fancylopedia* (Bristol/Speer)
- *Fancylopedia II* (Eney)
- *The Fillostrated Fan Dictionary*, 2 vol. (Weinstein) I have always had a bit of a problem with the focus on this but it is the most comprehensive compilation of fanspeak)
- *Science Fiction Fandom* (Sanders) (good anthology of fannish information)

Reprints:

- *A Sense of FAPA* (Eney) (this is the only reprint collection on the shelf because it does have a lot of historical material in it)
- *FanHistory* (Hoffman's fanhistory fanzine)
- *Entropy & Entropy* booklets (Carr's fanhistory fanzine))
- *FanHistorica* (Siclari's fanhistory fanzine))

These last three are mostly reprints but they have additional material. I have indexed them to find information.

Fanthologies, individual memoirs, fannish collections are kept accessible in the file cabinets but are not used as ready references. I have specifically excluded a few other pieces as duplicative (Niekas history pubs) or not very good (Rogow's *Futurespeak*).

Indexing

This issue I have included a couple of small indices. *Toto* was a reprint supplement to *Hyphen*. Different people were responsible for the selection and its page numbering system was varied. Sometimes it had its own page numbers, sometimes they were numbered as pages of *Hyphen*. The first index is by Author; the second is by Issue.

FANAC FanHistory Archives

The FanHistory web site is up and running. The first things put on-line have been a series of photo albums from Worldcons from 1939 to the present. There are well over 100 photos already on-line. Some of them can use additional identification. I expect that we will have a lot more photos in the near future. The next phase of the photo albums will be of fannish groups from different areas. I have some good photos of Irish Fandom, including some Ghoodminton matches in the Fan Attic, a few photos from England, and some from fan groups in the northeast and in the southeast. I am actively looking for more. I can scan photos and quickly get them on-line if you are willing to loan any of your photos. Photo credit will be provided, of course.

In addition to *Slant*, I will be putting selected issues of important fanzines on-line as graphics. I hope to eventually do some of these as formatted text files but that will take a while. If LoneStarCon decides to do the Retro Fan Hugos again, I will concentrate on getting the major 1946 fanzines on-line. Probably selected issues of *Acolyte*, *Bloomington Newsletter*, *Canadian Fandom*, *Fantasy Commentator*, *Shangri L'Affaires*, *Timebinder*, *Vampire*, *Voice of the ImagiNation* and even a bunch of *Fanews*, *Fantasy-Times* and *Stefnews*. Can you suggest some other good zines from 1946?

In addition to complete fanzines, we will have a section of major fannish articles, both as graphic images and as text files. The first of these is on the site, Laney's "Syllabus for a Fanzine" from *Spacewarp* 42. Any suggestions of other key articles? Eventually, I hope that this site will show the work of a lot of fen.



Again, I would appreciate comments and corrections on any of the things I put in the *Chronicle*.

Notes: items in (parentheses) are assumptions

- title illos of articles are listed as illos not headings

- when someone puts artwork in his own column, it is listed as an illo even if it is an unrelated fillo

- the number after the type of art (Ex. illo:3) is the number of pieces of art

- Pages indicate the actual pages an item is on (Ex. 4-7 is p.4 thru p.7 inclusive; 4, 7 means that something is on 4 & 7)

- reviewed items are listed in the notes

- Interlineations and very short uncredited fillers are not listed

- Names are listed as printed. (Ex. No attempt has been made to unify A. Vincent Clarke to Vince Clarke, Vinc Clarke or any other variation.)

- Titles are listed as printed on the page of the fanzine where they appear not as they might be in the ToC or on the cover. Exception: if a regular Column has a variant title, it is listed under the Column's title if discernible, with the variant in the notes.
