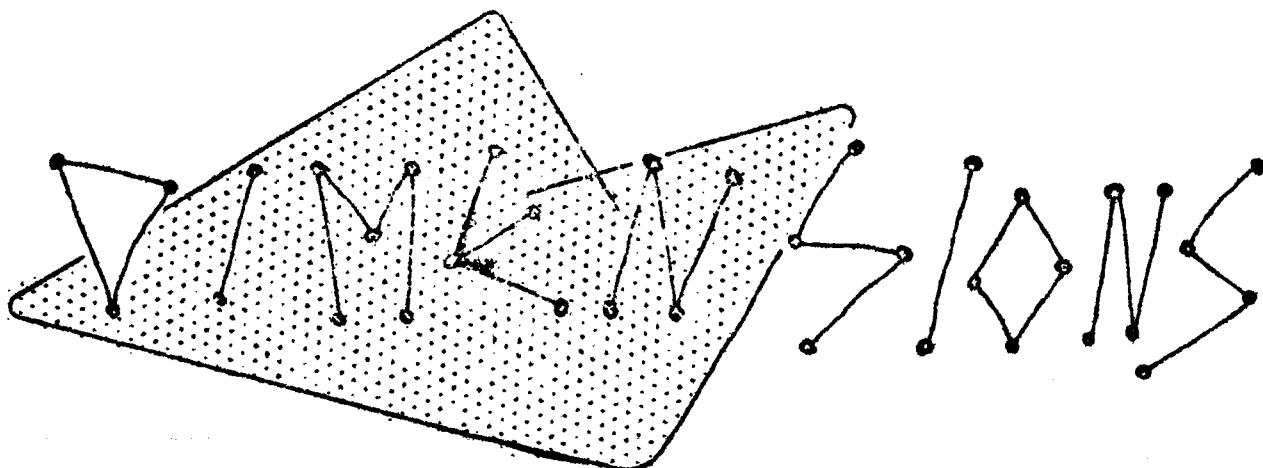


SCIENCE FANTASY BULLETIN ANNOUNCES
