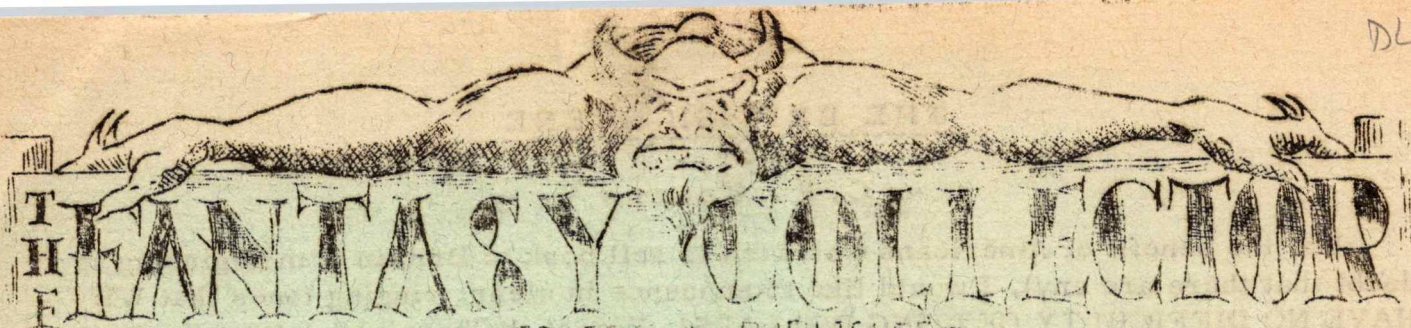

-- EDITORIAL --

We would like to draw our readers attention to some remarks made by Mr. Kearns in "The British Scene" appearing on the reverse of this page... regarding the difficulty British readers have in purchasing from American sources.

We can personally indorse his sentiments and add a few details from our own experience. First of all, as he states, payment in dollars is no longer a problem, so that the only real reason for avoiding overseas shipments may be the nuisance of preparing custom declarations as some post office employees seem to insist on.

Officially we do not know just when these are required, but we have shipped both books and magazines to Britain by preparing the package with open ends, and labeling the contents clearly, with the approximate value and the notation that "this package may be opened for inspection". As far as we have been able to tell, these packages have went through with no difficulty and with no further declarations of any kind. Of course one shbuld wrap well, extending the wrapping at least 1/4" beyond the contents and tying with stout string.

Postage is not really very expensive; the rate for books & sheet music to England is 3¢ for the first 2 ounces, 1-1/2 cents for each additional 2 ounces, a pound would be 13-1/2¢ only. Printed matter (magazines) may be sent for 5¢ for the first 2 oz., 3¢ for each additional 2 oz., up to a total of 6 pounds 8 ounces per package.

We think that anyone taking a little extra trouble to sell to your overseas customers would be more than amply repaid in many ways other than the cash. GB

THE BRITISH SCENE

For the benefit of Americans who wish to sell book to Britain (I'm beginning to doubt that there are any), I would like to announce in clear, ringing tones that WE HAVE NO DIFFICULTY GETTING DOLLARS! Forget the 'begging' letters in magazines of the past; as the cockney said, "them days is gorn"!

If I want to buy from America, I can get a dollar cheque, drawn on an American bank, from my bank, in 3 days; alternatively, I can get an International Money Order in dollars, (up to a limit of \$250 a year as a non-dealer) from any post-Office with no questions asked.

British subscribers write to me, saying "Why should I torment myself reading about books and magazines I can afford to buy -- when no one (but Rick Minter) will answer my letters?"

I should mention we expect to pay extra postage on our purchases -- so why not stimulate the flow of international trade and make yourselves some money....?

My vote for "Fantasy Painting of the Year" goes to Hannes Bok for his superb full cover dust-wrapper for the Llewelyn House re-issue of "The Secrets of Dr. Tavenner" -- which, incidentally, is a first rate collection of occult detective tales that carries it's age remarkably well.

The crudest artwork I have seen for years disgraces the cover of the "Panther" P.B. "The Case of Charles Dexter Ward" (2s/6d). The artist's name is Green, which describes the way I felt after one digusted look.

Digit House deserves a blast for messing up one of the best books of the year (in any sort of covers) -- "The Touch of Evil" by John Rakham (Digit R/658-2/6). This is the re-issue of the "Chappie Jones" stories from Science Fantasy. (Black Cats Paw, Ankh, Out of the Id). Obviously a further episode was written for the book -- how do I know? -- it's quoted on the "blurb" but is missing from the book! The storie which form a connected series are printed out of order (Ankh ends with "Chappie" happily married to Yalna; Out of the Id starts with both single again -- which is disconcerting to say the least).

However, read as 3 distinct tales of blackest magic and spine-tingling, blood-curdling terror, it is certainly worth the price of admission, and in Dr. Wilson, we have an occultist who makes John Silence look like a neophyte. If you liked "Dr Tavenner", you'll love this one.

Venture Science Fiction Magazine (Atlas, 128 pps, 2/6) which replaces "Analog" over here, has gotten off to a good start. Number 1, (Sept 1963) features Zenna Henderson's "Return", White's "Counter Security", Bester's "The Pie Man", plus 8 shorts and Pohl's "Binary Digits". Number 2 (October) bears the announcement "Published monthly -- next issue on sale Dec. 20? -- features "Red Hills of Summer" by Pangborn, "The Strange Ones" - Brackett, "The End of Evan Essant" by Sylvia Edwards, plus 6 shorts, including Sturgeon's "The Man Who Lost the Sea". I enjoyed every story in both issues.

Mike Moorcock's "The Stealer of Souls" (the Elric stories in hardcover) and George Hay (editor) - "Hell Hath Fury" (hardcover collection from "Unknown Worlds" have not yet been published, although due any day.

Spectrum III edited by Kingsley Amis & R. Conquest (Golancz, 18/; 272 pps) is best so far from this series, including as it does, such gems as "Killdozer" - Sturgeon, "The Voices of Time" - Ballard, "We Would See a Sign" - Rose, "Exploration Team" - Leinster, "Fondly Fahrenheit" - Bester, "The Sentinel" - Clarke and "Call Me Joe" - Anderson. -- By all means!
