A Note to prospective members:

The cost of joining the MSFC is \$2.00 per year. An attendance fee is also charged of .50. The \$2.00 goes towards the maintenance of the club in general. The .50 has to cover the cost of games facilities, electric supply, supper and last but not least the cost of books and magazines for the library. Membership of the club automatically entitles members to attend all meetings and to be members of the MFF Group. The attendance fee on Film nights covers the cost of the film and the supper.
