INCLUDING: SCIENCE FICTION, FANTASY, MOVIES ETC.....

INTRODUCTION:

This list is prepared by the MELBOURNE SF CLUB LIBRARY for members and friends. If you would like to receive it regularly please ask us to put you on our mailing list. We have been producing this list for some years but this is the second of a new series. It will become more comprehensive as it progresses and we hope to give more information about the individual books. We are also preparing a list of all the SF and allied books available which we hope to have completed early next year. Plenty of copies of the first issue of this new series of SF booklists are available on request.

All the books listed are new or recent titles and many are not yet published. Many of the prices are only approximate and are subject to alteration, though they are unlikely to vary very much. They will be split in to three main sections: American Science fiction and Fantasy hard cover books and paperbacks, British SF and Fantasy hard covers and paperbacks and other books of special interest. The other books of special interest will include graphic art and comics, non-fiction, movies, scientific and whatever else I consider may be of interest to you all.

Orders for any of these books can be sent to the Melbourne Science Fiction Library or to McGills Newsagency, 187 Elizabeth Street, Melbourne 3000. Payment in advance is requested for all orders. Postage is extra. One paperback on the average would cost 12c, two paperbacks 18c, three paperbacks or one hard cover 24c. More than this varies according to destination. If you have any difficulty in working this out do not worry as an account will be enclosed with your order. Orders from MSFC Members are subject to 10% discount from the MSFL only. All orders for more than one ADVENT title are subject to 10% discount. Libraries are entitled to 10% on all orders. Wholesale orders for ADVENT books to MSFL only less 1/3 discount.

Many of the books ordered from this list can be supplied from stock or in a few weeks time, but as many are advance titles it may take some months before they are available.

Most of the American titles are in very limited supply, especially hard covers & we will not guarantee delivery under six weeks, but if you get your order in as early as possible after receiving this list, you will have every chance of being supplied out of our initial shipment of paperback titles.

All the SCIENCE FICTION Magazines are available from the MSFL or McGills. The MSFL has some back issues including copies of VISION Magazine and can obtain back issues of most magazines for you. We have been asked to dispose of a large collection of early magazines and a list of these will be distributed early in the New Year. Copies of FAN MAGAZINES available from the MSFL at the moment include SF COMMENTARY, NORSTRILIAN NEWS, SCIENCE FICTION REVIEW, The MSFL's own magazine of course THE SOMERSET GAZETTE and we are expecting copies of ERBDOM and STARDOCK or GOTHIC. We will be increasing our range of Fanzines as we get organised. We will be carrying of course all the publications of John Bangsund and we have a few odd copies of back numbers of AUSTRALIAN SF REVIEW, the HUGO Nominee. Information about all the fan publications will be sent on request. A limited number of the EASTERCON 1970 souvenir booklet edited by JB and profusely illustrated.....well it has a good selection of photos from BARBERALLA and it is printed on offset, are available at 50c each.

We can supply the needs of SF Fans, movie fans and comic fans. As well as books and magazines we are expecting a range of posters from the USA not otherwise available here. Copies of STERENKO's large size paperback book on the HISTORY OF COMICS, which not only covers with examples all the comics published in the USA for years back, but also all the pulp magazines. This is really worth having at \$3 plus postage 24c.

Time is the essence with all our activities at the moment, especially since this list is still a labour of love. However we will be distributing as early as possible a complete list of all the sf books that we can obtain for you. In the meantime if there is any title you want we will do our best to obtain it for you if we do not already have it in stock.

An explanation of our abbreviations:

The majority of titles listed are Science Fiction Novels and are marked SF, but in some cases we are not certain if these are novels and even sf or fantasy, in which case the SF or F will be followed by a ?. We have marked some with a J or JUV and these are titles specially written for children. The Heinlein Juveniles and say Hal Clement books, are just as popular with adults. In the opposite direction many of the adult titles are suitable for children but at this time we have not found it practical to mark all of them. I hope that at a later date we will be able to make up a special list for schools and libraries. Two or three books have been written on sf for schools and we will advise on the details and availability of these on request.

There are two types of short story collections: SSA means by the author. SSE means edited by author given. MSF means mainstream Science Fiction SF written by an author who is better known for other than sf writing, or a story which only uses the SF gimmicks to put over certain ideas and is aimed at the general reader rather than the SF fan.

There are basically two types of FANTASY. H for Horror including weird, black magic, ghosts and similar type stories. F for Fantasy including Swords and sorcery, like CONAN and stories like the LORD of the RINGS and most of the titles by Lin Carter, Sprague de Camp and all the titles in the BALLANTINE Fantasy series such as Worm Ouroboros by Edison.

I must point out that this is in many cases our idea of what is SF or Fantasy and as many titles are border line we won't argue with you as to which is which.

The prices of most of the titles are correct, especially the paper backs. Many of the titles are marked npa - NO PRICE AVAILABLE. Others marked 'a' means approximate. These are mainly titles not yet published.

BOOKS OF SPECIAL INTEREST and NOTES on TITLES in the FOLLOWING LIST

A recent addition to the names of US Publishers publishing SF was CURTIS. They started out by publishing a series of titles like COUNTERCOMMANDMENT by J.W.Campbell and FINAL ENCOUNTER by Pohl which turned out to be reprints of Analog and Galaxy collections. This was a very poor start and they now seem to have gone in the other direction with original titles like MY NAME IS VLADIMIR SLOIFOISKI by B.Alper and The GRUACHAN OF KILLANE by an author with the unlikely name of Cristabel.

A most welcome reprint in the Swords and Sorcery field is The BROKEN SWORD by Poul Anderson. Ballantine publishers are doing a great job for the fantasy fans with their Fantasy series of which the Broken Sword is one of the latest editions. Other titles include FIGURES of EARTH and SOMETHING ABOUT EVE by J.B.Cabell, GOLDEN CITIES by Lin Carter who is also editing the series, The WORM OUBOROUS series of 4 books by E.R.Eddison, The WELL AT WORLDS END in two volumes by W.Morris, The Mervyn Peake GORMANGHAST Trilogy, All the TOLKIEN Books, DERYNI RISING by Kathryn Kurtz and AT THE EDGE OF THE WORLD by Lord Dunsany. With all the other titles in this series plus all the other titles from other publishers on this list or already published, the Swords and sorcery fan is very well looked after.

FIVE FATES is a collection of five stories by Anderson, Herbert, Dickson, Ellison and Laumer on the theme of survival after EUPHENASIA. Published in the US hard cover edition in August at \$4.95.

QUEEN ZIXI of IX and SEA FAIRIES are titles by L.Frank Baum famous for the Wizard of OZ series of which I believe both of these are part. A childrens fairy story which adults also enjoy.

I do not have many details on John Brunner's new title the DEVILS WORK so I do not know at this stage if it is sf or not. If it is anything like SQUARES OF THE CITY or STAND ON ZANZIBAR it should be worth reading.

We have had an order into Mirage Press for some of their books for some time like The CONAN SWORD BOOK which has still not arrived. We are also waiting on DRAGONS and NIGHTMARES. If you still want a copy of this title having already ordered it previously, please order from us again.

L.Sprague de Camp seems to have got lost in the days of the Dinosaurs, what with DAYS of the DINOSAURS and A GUN FOR DINOSAUR from CURTIS and DEMONS and DINOSAURS from Arkham.

I hope the new title from ACE called NOAH 11 which is an original story by Roger Dixon from an idea by Basil Bova, about mans journey to the stars after the Earth has become uninhabitable. They claim a motion picture is to be made of it also.

Two follow ups to titles by Harlan Ellison are on the way. AGAIN DANGEROUS VISIONS will not be published till some time early in 1970 and SON of the GLASS TEAT should not make the scene much earlier.

Good news for Phillip Jose Farmer's many fans is the two books from ACE on the way. The STONE GOD AWAKENS and the double The MAD GOBLIN and LORD of the TREES. These seem very similar to two books published by a certain publisher who specialised in pornographic books who has since gone bust. Rewrites ???

The master of the 'adventures in time' story Jack Finney has had a large illustrated volume called TIME and AGAIN - New York in 1980 published by Simon and Schuster.

This re-titling problem once again rears its ugly head with The JUPITER LEGACY by Harry Harrison which was previously the Plague from Space. Harry is one of our most prolific editors or author with eight books to his credit on the list.

NOTES on other British books already listed:

The ICE PEOPLE by Rene Barjal is translated from the original French by Charles L.Markham.It a novel about the remnants of a 900,000 year old civilization discovered in the Antarctic.

The series edited by Ted CARNELL ,NEW WRITINGS IN SF are all being reprinted.The first three are now on sale . Corgis at 65c.

TANDAM BOOKS appear to have stepped up their SF output and the most notable release in their paperback series is the LIN CARTER books :- THONGOR AGAINST THE GODS,IN THE CITY OF MAGICIANS ,OF LEMURIA and WIZARD OF LEMURIA .The cover illustrations on many of the British paperbacks are very unimaginative.SPHERE Books and CORGIS and MAYFLOWER are not bad but PAN are ugly and PENGUINS I think are too stylised.The covers on the THONGOR books from TANDAM are not bad but spoilt by the 'framing'.

After a long break Edmund CRISPIN has come to light again with another of his BEST SF collections .This is number 7.In the past he has chosen well and they have sold well in hc and paper back.

Robert HEINLEIN still remains one of the most popular authors.Fans will be glad to know that all his Scribner Juveniles will be issued by ACE in the USA .British versions are coming from GOLLANCZ in hard coverand their latest release is HAVE SPACE SUIT WILL TRAVEL. Heinlein's Juveniles as they are so called,are better than many of the adult titles published of other authors .

One of our most prolific authors at the moment is Michael Moorcock the editor of NEW WORLDS,(This is going to be published in USA in a quarterly paperback edition now that the British edition has ceased,MM will still be editor as far as I know.) and amongst the titles by him in both the US and British lists , is a title CURE FOR CANCER which is the latest in a series featuring the character 'Jerry Cornelius'.This not exactly SF and I also have my doubts about Damon Knight's FORT.More details on these later.

The main items of interest for Robert E Howard fans are the paperbacks from CENTAUR Books of SOLOMON KANE and HAND of KANE. Actually these were announced some months back but as far as I know have not hit the book shops yet. The same goes for SINGERS in the SHADOWS, the collection of Poetry from Donald M. Grant Publisher. The two Lancer Conantitles listed in our last issue CONAN of AQUILONIA and CONAN the BUCCANEER are still not listed for any publication date.

The HUGO WINNER Ursula K. Le Guinn has only one reprint on this list CITY of ILLUSION from ACE. The winning novel itself LEFT HAND of DARKNESS is available in hard cover from McDonald Publishers at 4.25. The paperback has been published by ACE at 90cents.

The HUGO winning Best SF Novella also appeared in Ace and that is Fritz Leiber's SHIP of SHADOWS in the WORLDS BEST SF 1970. The Short story winner this year was TIME CONSIDERED AS A HELIX OF SEMI-PRECIOUS STONES by Samuel R. Delaney and this appeared in the ACE WORLDS BEST SF 1969.

Another retitle: CITY of the BEAST by Moorcock was WARRIOR of MARS by his alter ego E.P. Bradbury.

Two much wanted reprints are Larry Nivens duo NEUTRON STAR and WORLD of PTAUVS from Ballantine. Please reorder if you have asked up for these a long time back.

Two new titles from Alexei Panshin are announced by Ace but at the moment I have no date on their publication: The UNIVERSAL PANTOGRAPH and A SENSE of DIRECTION.

Another unknown quantity is a series of three books published by PINNACLE Books who are either a new firm or an old firm brought to life again, called CATAclysm, The GUNS of TERRA and 1989: POPULATION DOOMSDAY all of which are by Don Pendleton.

PRIDE of MONSTERS by popular author James H. Schmitz would be I think a collection of his stories. A reprint is also coming of The WITCHES of KARNAS from Ace.

Beware of TOWER Books. They are turning out some mildly sexy rubbish WEIGHTLESS in GAZA being a good example of same.

A very welcome reprint is Corwainer Smith's YOU WILL NEVER BE THE SAME. UNDER OLD EARTH in Panther edition includes reprints but also some stories not seen in book form before. None of them I believe in a British edition before.

Of the new writers the author of BUG JACK BARON Norman Spinrad will be one of the most talked about and his new title is coming from AVON soon called The LAST HURRAH of the GOLDEN HORSE.

More reprints include James Whites Star Surgeon series HOSPITAL STATION and STAR SURGEON.

If you want a laugh read Robert Moore Williams JONGOR series. They are set in ancient Australia and he has made no attempt to rationalise his stories with known ancient Australian animals and Aboriginal legends. There is a marvellous wealth of material here for a local author to draw on. What about it fellers? It wont take much effort to better this JONGOR junk.

A new fantasy novel coming from Allen and Unwin in England and Ballantines in USA in the new year is RED MOON and BLACK MOUNTAIN by Joy Chant. It is written by a young childrens librarian and amongst all the fantasy that is being published of this nature at present, Allen and Unwin claim this one is outstanding.

A little bit out of the field but of probable interest to some of our readers is A DICTIONARY of CHIVALRY by Grant Uden, Longmans 7.95. Beautifully illustrated, with line and coloured drawings of Knighthood in all its aspects.

BOOKS OF SPECIAL INTERESTCOMICS and ART:

THE HISTORY OF COMICS as advertised in the Marvel Comics by Steranko is now available .It is even better than expected .As well as covering the American comics in great detail,it also includes a wealth of material with illustrations on the pulp magazines including SF ,the Super Heroes like Doc Savage ,and Westerns.It is a large sized 11 x 17 inches with a paper cover in full cover depicting dozens of the comic heroes and villains.
