With this issue, I inaugurate a slightly new policy on move reporting: all units not ordered will have the appropriate Stand or Hold orders filled in, preceded by an asterisk [\*]. This, together with the new form for the situation report initiated in issue #9, should considerably facilitate interpretation of these Notes. I now intend to retain the Sector Numbers in the reported orders, since they can be readily interpreted by reference to the previous or following situation report. Onward!
