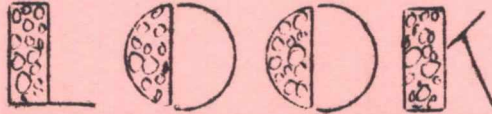

Can anyone advise whether Haggard's SWALLOW is a fantastic? If it isn't, I see no point in plowing through the ancient MUNSEY MAG. with it.

A NEWSPAPER MARVEL - Royal. ARGOSY Apr. 1902. A newspaper is invented that employs so simple a code that it can be condensed onto a single sheet of paper, yet when read from a machine gives a full account of recent affairs. However, it becomes so widely read that a small typographical error changes the whole content of an article and almost starts a war.

AN AMATEUR GHOST - Cabell. ARGOSY Feb. 1902. The protagonist becomes an understudy to a ghost. A really delightful bit of fantasy.

AT THE LAND'S END - Jared Fuller. ARGOSY May-June-July-Aug.-Sept.-Oct.-Nov. 1901. Tradegar, the protagonist, flees England because of a vindictive and grasping aunt. Reaching New York, out of funds, he falls in with Craig, who plans a trip to find Andree. The expedition is to be made by aeroplane. They fall in with Miss Carryl and one Jinny. Creidon plans, however, to murder the whole expedition, but they escape, after saving Jinny from death by the narrowest margins. All goes well until the engine fails, and Tradegar is forced to land the machine in a canyon. A landslide buries it, and Preston and Craig, out looking for aid, vanish; Tradegar goes to find them, but finds only one; however, they discover that the land they are on is but a huge iceberg, drifting out to sea! More later.

MARTIN BRADLEY'S SPACE ANNIHILATOR - Cummins. A man invents a sort of wireless telephone, but is killed in the Boxer rebellion, and his machine destroyed. Interesting.

IN THE DAYS OF THE COMET - H.G. Wells. COSMOPOLITAN Dec. 1905-Jan. Feb.-Mar.-Apr.-May-June-July-Aug.-Sept. 1906.

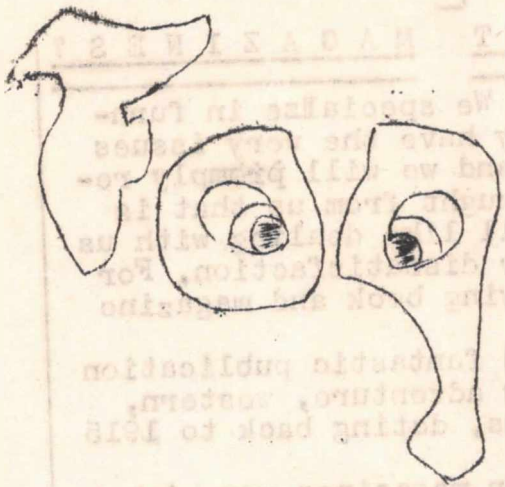
I won't go into detail with this one, as it is the first of his unreadable potboilers. Let alone to say it concerns the effect of an impending collision of our world with a comet on politics and sociological processes. I really just wanted to point out the fact that it appeared here.

THE MYSTERIOUS ISLAND - Verne. SCRIBNERS May-June-July-Aug.-Sept.-Oct.-Nov.-Dec. 1874 Jan.-Feb.-Mar. 1875. Again, there is no value in the story (another, even less readable potboiler), but I just wanted to point out the fact for the benefit of whoever might be interested.

Grogory's ABOVE THE POLE STAR (revised recently) was published in MAN STORIES for Feb. 1931.

THE MYSTERIOUS ISLAND - Verne. SCRIBNERS May-June-July, Aug, SepOct Nov, Dec. 1974; Jan, Feb, Mar. 1975. Again, there is no value in the story, but I just want to get this data published for whoever might be interested.

THE FIRST MEN IN THE MOON - Wells. COSMOPOLITAN Nov, Dec 1900; Jan, Feb, Mar, Apr, May, Jun 1901. This is a first rate story on the classic moon voyage theme, this time accomplished by means of a matter-repellant known as Cavorite. This publication was graced with magnificent illustrations of scenes on our satellite, and belongs in the collection of every serious student.
