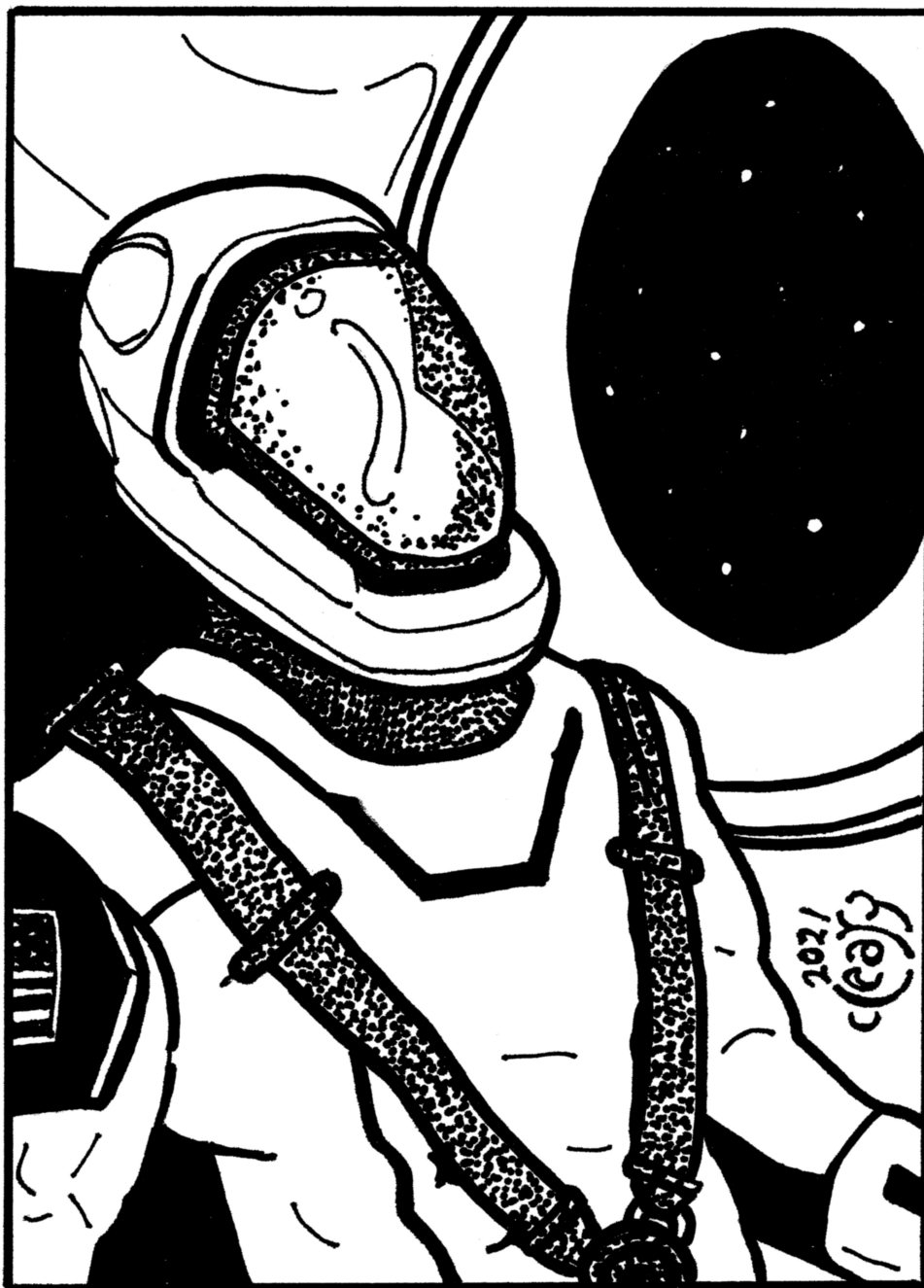

This issue of the *Bulletin* is edited by R. B. Cleary. Membership in the SFC is \$15 annually, running from DeepSouthCon to DeepSouthCon. A club or convention membership is \$50 annually. Donations are welcome. All checks should be made payable to the Southern Fandom Confederation. The *Bulletin* is also available for trades, published contributions, and letters of comment.

Permission is granted to reprint all articles, lists, and flyers so long as the author and the *Bulletin* are credited. All art is copyrighted by the artist, unless otherwise specified. An exception is granted in the case of art that appears in a convention flyer.

The editor encourages submission of lengthy written material and art – covers and illos. Contributions and LoCs via electronic means are highly desirable. If you wish to use the Internet, you may send the article as electronic mail or an attachment. If you wish to send the editor computer media, IBM compatible file formats are acceptable. Media will be returned if requested. The *Bulletin* is laid out in Apache Open Office 4 on a Windows laptop. Ink and typewritten submissions are also graciously accepted. If you're not sure what all this means, get in touch to work out a solution.

### PHOENIX, REBEL AND RUBBLE WINNERS FROM DSC 59

On July 10, 2021 at ConGregarate 7 / DeepSouthCon 59, in High Point, NC, the Phoenix, Rebel and Rubble awards were presented. The 2021 Phoenix Award was presented to **Allen Wold**, professional author of many SF, Fantasy, and weird publications since 1978, and who has been running a writer's workshop at almost every convention he attends, since 1987. The 2022 Rebel Award was presented to **Cheralyn Lambeth**, who is proud to be a long-time charter member of the 501st Legion, serving on the Legion's History/Archives team. She is also an active paranormal investigator with the Charlotte Area Paranormal Society, and founder/team captain of the Southern Belle Ghostbusters.. The 2021 Rubble Award (faux award created by Gary Robe) was awarded to <No Award>.

### PASSINGS

Noted Author and good friend of LibertyCon, **Lou Antonelli**, passed away on October 6th, 2021 after contracting pneumonia. Lou was a author and a journalist and had been a regular at LibertyCon the last few years doing Alternate History panels and panels on the craft of writing.

**Darrell R. Osborn** passed away on December 1, 2021. He was born on July 1, 1959 in Orleans, France, but grew up in Trenton, KY. Darrell was a well-known local celebrity in the U.S. Southeast, where he performed as Doctor Osborn. His magic shows, comedy and "Balloons of Doom" brought smiles to countless children and adults throughout the southeast for decades. He also won awards for magic, comedy, and ventriloquism.

**Ronald R. "Zeke" Zukowski**, 72, of Atlanta, GA, died Sunday, December 19, 2021, in Douglasville, GA. He served as Co-Chair of ConFederation, World of Science Fiction Convention (1986), attended DragonCon conventions, was a member of the Atlanta Radio Theater Company, and was a published science fiction author. In 2014, he received the annual Hank Reinhardt Fan Award for his leadership in Science Fiction activities.

DeepSouthCon 59 Chair and DSC 57 Rebel Award winner, **Jeff Smith**, from North Carolina, who chaired numerous StellarCon and MACE conventions, passed away the evening of February 28th, 2022, after a short battle with an aggressive form of cancer.

**Rick Albertson**, Executive Producer of the 1986 Atlanta Worldcon (Confederation) and tech at multiple Worldcons, passed away in his apartment March 1, 2022. Rick was one of the real greats of Worldcon Tech. He could always get things to work, and did so with a smile. He drifted away from cons some years back. He had a wonderful light sense of humor and very little self-importance.

**Samanda B. Jeude**, who helped create the early convention disability access services organization that became Electrical Eggs, died July 3, 2022 at the age of 69.

CoastCon friend, Fan, filker, volunteer, and past Fan Guest of Honor, **Harry Alm**, passed on July 15, 2022. As a Fan he and his partner/life-mate Marilyn Alm are founders of one of oldest Fan groups in the South, Ista Weyr, a group devoted to Dragonriders of Pern and the many other worlds/series of legendary Science Fiction and Fantasy author, Anne McCaffrey. Harry and Marilyn were involved with conventions and events all across the Deep South and their work as filkers leaves a legacy any Fannish musician and Fan would be very proud to call their own.

SF writer **Eric Flint**, 75, died July 17, 2022. Flint was best known for his Assiti Shards Universe, starting with 1632 (2000), in which a modern small town and all its inhabitants are transported back in time. Eric Flint was a regular guest, panelist, and attendee to many southern conventions.

**Larry Montgomery**, age 77, passed away September 7, 2022. He was a member of the Southern Fandom Press Alliance since 1963.

### Hank Reinhardt Award

**John Carroll** won the 2022 Hank Reinhardt Award given out by Dragon Con (formerly known as the Georgia Fan Award. Hank was its first recipient.) It is presented annually at Dragon\*Con to honor an outstanding Georgia writer, artist, or fan.

## **SFC BY-LAWS AS OF 2022**

SECTION 1 (a) The Southern Fandom Confederation is a non-profit organization of, by, and for science fiction and fantasy fans residing in the states of Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Virginia; existing for the purpose of promoting fan and professional activity within that area. (b) The President shall have the discretion to name as “Southern Sympathizers” persons or groups outside the South for the purpose of membership and participation in the SFC.

SECTION 2. The SFC shall meet once a year, simultaneously and at the same place as the DeepSouthCon, hereafter DSC. In the event a DSC is not held in a given year, the SFC officers may agree on a time and place for the annual meeting, preferably at an alternate southern convention, and will announce that information to the membership in a timely manner. This meeting shall be open to all dues-paid and dues-exempt SFC members, plus interested parties. Only Dues-paid or -exempt members may speak or vote except through dispensation by the presiding officer. Each meeting shall consist of: (a) a review of the year's activity, (b) election

of officers, and (c) suggestions from the membership for activities in the year ahead.

SECTION 3. The officers of the SFC shall consist of (a) President, (b) Vice President, (c) Secretary, and (d) Treasurer. All officers of the SFC must reside within the Confederacy. All are elected to one-year terms of office. Other than the President, any two (2) offices may be combined for one year at the option of the membership present and voting at the meeting at which officers are elected. Without specifically voting to combine two offices, the membership may effectively accomplish the same result by electing the same person to two offices; however, no person shall be allowed to be elected as President if already elected to serve in another office during the same or overlapping term(s) of office and no person elected as President shall be allowed to be elected to serve in another office during the same or overlapping term(s) of office.

(a) The President shall run the annual SFC business meeting, present a summary of the year's activities, set SFC policy on matters of controversy, publish the official



SFC bulletin on a tri-annual basis, and represent the SFC at all fannish functions.

(b) The Vice President shall serve in the place of the President should the President be absent. The Vice President shall also assist the President in special projects and other duties as requested by the President within reason.

(c) The secretary of the SFC, in conjunction with the other officers, shall maintain a file of all active Southern fans, clubs, amateur press alliances, conventions, and related fannish enterprises (including those available only electronically) and shall work to disseminate information about these persons, publications, organizations, and events to interested parties, especially members of the SFC. The Secretary shall also maintain the minutes, records, and other documents of the SFC created and/or used during the Secretary's term of office, and shall turn over said minutes, records, and other documents to the Archivist upon completion of the Secretary's term of office. The Secretary shall take minutes of the SFC Business meeting and the DSC Business Meeting held at DeepSouthCon during her or his term of office and shall prepare a report of same to be submitted to the president for publication in the Bulletin. The Secretary shall also assist the President and the Vice President upon request within reason. In the event of the absence of the President and the Vice President, the Secretary shall preside.

(d) The Treasurer shall collect dues for the SFC and maintain an account at a convenient bank on which only the Treasurer or the President may draw. The Treasurer is responsible for mailing the official Bulletin at the cheapest possible rate. The Treasurer shall also assist the other officers at request within reason. In the absence of all other officers, the Treasurer shall preside.

SECTION 4. Dues for the SFC are \$15.00 per year for an individual, with institutional dues being \$50.00 per year, a year being defined as the period between successive DeepSouthCons. Payment of institutional dues also entitles the organization so paying to one free advertisement in the SFC bulletin. The following are dues-exempt: (a) Winners of the Rebel and Phoenix Awards presented at the DSC, (b) Individuals who have performed such service to the organization that the

President feels they merit exemption, (c) SFC officers during their term of service.

SECTION 5. The official SFC Bulletin shall be published at least every four months. The contents of each issue shall be left to the discretion of the President/editor, but shall include the following: one issue each year shall include a comprehensive list of Southern SF clubs, apas, fanzines, and/or dues-paid and -exempt SFC members. Other material in the bulletin shall be concerned with Southern fandom's history, present activity & future plans.

Editorial policy: (a) The bulletin shall concern itself freely with controversial matters confronting Southern Fandom. All editorial opinions shall be signed by the author and shall not be considered reflective of the opinions of any officer of the SFC itself. (b) The bulletin shall maintain a neutral position between and among competing bids for DSC, or between and among Southern contenders for a Worldcon. (c) A letter column shall be printed in each issue containing a comprehensive spectrum of opinion on any matter before the SFC. (d) The SFC shall promote the candidacy of Southern fans and professionals for fAndOm-wide honors such as the Hugo Award. (Capitalization courtesy Guy Lillian, as reported by Tim Gatewood, SFC Secretary.)

SECTION 6. This set of by-laws may be amended or replaced by the SFC members in attendance at the DSC meeting. Any amendment proposed in writing and signed by 20 or more SFC members must be brought before this meeting and voted upon. A majority of members at the meeting may cause an amendment to be brought to a vote. A 2/3 majority of members voting shall be sufficient to cause an amendment to pass.
