Probably the most sought-after of all WARPs is the January 49 issue. In late 1948, Rapp had been publishing the zine on a borrowed mimeograph, and at the end of the year returned this to the owners in Detroit. At the same time, Radell Nelson was forced to discontinue his excellent zine, UNIVERSE, because of the pressure of school work. Rapp was also having a time getting WARP out and keeping up his college work at the same time.

Hastily, Rapp and Nelson agreed to merge UNIVERSE and SPACEWARP, Rapp to cut stencils, Nelson to run them off. However, delay occurred in both phases of this, and when March had arrived -- and the zine not yet out -- plans were changed again.

The stencils were sent to George Young, who eventually got them run off. But meanwhile, the subscription list had not been accurately kept since December, and eventually the master copy of the list vanished.

Thus George was able to send the January SPACEWARP-UNIVERSE only to the names on a list reconstructed from memory. By the time the original list was rediscovered, the remaining copies of the issue had vanished. And the stencils had been destroyed after running the edition.

In consequence, many a subscriber missed getting a January 1949 WARP -- even some of the contributors to that issue. Current bidding price on the issue is 20¢, and no takers.

If you have one of these precious copies in your collection, guard it well, and upon your retirement from fandom, it will net you a bit of cash!
