



In Explanation

Fanzines are listed in alphabetical order followed by the name and address of the editor-publisher. The data beneath each shows, in order: (1) the manner of duplication, (2) supposed periodicity of publication, (3) number of issues published in 1944, (4) average number of pages, and (5) the stated single copy price. The letters "XL" appearing in the fifth position indicate that fanzine has no stated price and is obtained by exchange or letters to the editor. An Asterisk (*) indicates the fanzine is not now publishing.


