First of all they are publishing the British edition Kingsley Amis's NEW MAPS ofHELL - a survey of sf ,reviewed in time and a must for all serious readers of sf, which will be in A tralia very soon. Arthur Clarke's THE OTHER SIDE of the SKY is also due soon. Others to come include NEEDLE -Hal Clement, GUARDIANS of TIME -Anderson, VOICE of the DOLPHIN S- short stories by nuclear physcisist Dr Leo Sziland, SPECTRUM—short stories selected by Kingsley Amis and Robert Conquest and another title which is already out and selling at 17/- is the original Galaxy serial, WOLFEBANE -Pohl and Kornbluth. It is very nice to see a publisher showing such faith in the field and I hope he is rewarded. Although only a fewhave been published by Gollance in the past, they have been first class items like Earth Abides, More Than Human, The Disappearance, Angels and Spaceships and more recently Dragon in the Sea. Mr Gollancze is a ardent believer of the phrase 'never judge a book by its cover', as almost a secondry thought as it is a very sore point with me being a bookssiler.
