Vale George Turner 1916 - 1997

George Turner, writer, critic and one of the strongest voices in Australian fiction died on Sunday June 8, aged 80. He had a massive stroke on Thursday and did not regain consciousness. George made a huge contribution to the development and improvement of Australian science fiction. His dry wit and incisive comment made him an invaluable contributor to any discussion of science and fiction. He promised to dance on the tables with Bruce Gillespie at Aussiecon Three; I'm sorry I won't see that.
