

The 1998 DITMAR nomination form (web version) will be updated very soon, while hard copies are winging their ways to various SF bookshops & cons as I type. The nomination deadline had been set as March 20, but has been extended to April 4 to allow votes to be received from attendees at conventions near that time (where they will hopefully encounter nomination forms). Given the delay in getting the forms out, this gives everyone a bit more time all round."


