# The Reader's Guide to Barsoom and Amtor

In the few weeks since "The Reader's Guide to Barsoom and Amtor" was announced in a mailing to 250 members of the Burroughs Bibliophiles, almost 100 orders have been placed, and they are still arriving almost daily. In view of this interest, we have decided to extend the offer to a wider public, including the readers of THE FANTASY COLLECTOR. Here is the information.

"The Reader's Guide to Barsoom and Amtor" will be a mimeographed booklet dealing with the planets Barsoom and Amtor -- Mars and Venus -- as visualized in Edgar Rice Burroughs' series of books detailing the adventurous life on those two worlds. The main feature of the Guide is a 15,000 word study of Barsoom by David G. Van Arnam. Accompanying this study is an 11"x17" foldout, two-color map of Barsoom, by Larry Ivie. Mr. Ivie contributes an additional 5,000 words on the topic of the geographical problems posed by the ten Mars books.

The Guide will be mailed unstapled for the convenience of any reader who wishes to frame either the Krenkel print or the Ivie map.

"The Reader's Guide to Barsoom and Amtor" is both a literary and a visual treat for all Burroughs fans, and is certain to become a collector's item in coming years. Barring unexpected delays, it will be published in June, 1963.
