## - EDITORIAL -

1. Zip Codes -- the last minute request for your "Zip Code" number in the last issue brought a good response, but there are still many who have not furnished them. We are preparing a new master mailing list to be used starting in September and would very much like to have all codes you intend to furnish on hand by the last of August.

2. Michael Moorcock: a letter from this British author regarding the C.R. Kearns review of his "Dead God's Homecoming" in the last issue of F.C. was received some days ago. In the interests of fair play, we will include portions of this letter as space permits:

"...Aside from the fact that I am not very familiar with some of the writers he mentions, I note that Mr Kearns has misquoted, mis read -- and in some cases, misspelled (ye editor may be responsible here) -- me pretty consistently so that I gather the story affected him to the extent his reading was impaired. I have never read or heard of Kadath beyond the Cold Waste, admit that there are rather too many names in the story -- although anyone familiar with the rest of the series would presumably not be in the same confusion... I am of the opinion that, in the heat of the moment, Mr Kearns seized upon this flaw because he did not have the time or perhaps analytical ability to define exactly why he disliked the story so much... Let me say I am not offended by Mr Kearns dislike of my stories (or myself for that matter) since I myself thought it time someone wrote a piece commenting unfavourably on them...."
