

OF MEMBERS AND 'ZINES (AND EGOBOO POLLS) Feb. 1981.

The FAPA index is compiled by Peggy Rae Pavlat, 5709 Goucher Drive, College Park, Maryland, 20740. The purpose of the index is to make voting in the Egoboo Poll easier (assuming that this year we get a set of instructions which people can follow without a lot of hassle). The theory is that if you make it easy for people to vote intelligently, they will vote. We'll see....it hasn't worked overly well in the past. On the other hand, from time to time people have used the index for other purposes and so it still seems like a worthwhile project.

Material by each individual who was a member during any part of 1980 is included, whether the material is in his/her own fanzine or another's fanzine. Material by people who are not members of FAPA is counted as a contribution of the person who did the fanzine in which it appears. Franked material is usually ignored. Notations to the right of the mailing date (Feb, May, Aug, Nov) signify that the person had material in another person's fanzine of the type indicated (letter, article, etc.) except for the notation postmailing, which simply means that the fanzine was postmailed. In these cases, the editor/publisher is noted in parenthesis immediately after the title of the fanzine. If no activity is noted after a person's name, then no activity was in the mailings or postmailings.
