In the Theater, where I was the only person ever to be employed as sound technician, we used BASF standard play, & it is a very nice tape to edit, the next-best over here is EMI tape, which was too thin for our purposes. If enybody wants advice on how to prepare tapes for a play, they can write me

Over here, we have a practise of building up a record library by borrowing recoreds & transfering them to 3 inch spools of long play tape (using old standard 8 mm film spools). If any of you are interested in doing the same, a contake couple of hints....First, listen to both sides of the record, A to time them, so you don't waste tape, & B to check recording level if not using an AVC. And when you are playing back, use one of the large-centered spools such as you get with pre-recorded tapes of records. This will stop the tape from getting permanently kinky t dut to spending all of its life wrapped around a small diameter core.

With very thin tapes, you will, over a period of time, get a mank week signal corssing over from one layer of tape to the next. The thing to do to avoid this is to rewind the tapes, or play them that least once very 6 months which will slightly alter the position of the tape on the spool.
